NEW online application for Adult Abuse Registry and Child Abuse Registry self-check

Manitoba Family Services' Adult Abuse Registry (AAR) and Child Abuse Registry (CAR) are official lists, containing the names of people convicted of abuse or neglect of a child or vulnerable adult, as defined by Manitoba law.

These registries help protect Manitoba children and vulnerable adults. Employers and organizations can screen potential employees, volunteers or even foster parents who work, or may work, with a child or vulnerable adult.

It is common for Manitoba organizations and employers to ask employees and volunteers to complete their own registry checks as part of regular screening and hiring practices.

Benefits of applying online:

- one application for both registries
- accessible 24-hours a day
- no line ups and no travel time
- a confidential and secure way to send personal information and payment
- no extra fees to apply online

Applicants are notified when their applications are received and when results are available. Your results can be picked up, or sent out by mail.

NOTE: Online applications are only available for persons completing CAR and AAR self-checks.
