By signing my name, I understand that the Director of Child and Family Services is obtaining my personal information (including, if necessary for identification purposes, my Manitoba Health Registration Number) so that the Director can provide me with post-adoption services under *The Adoption Act*. I understand that my personal information is being collected under the authority of subsection 36(1)(b) of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and that my personal health information, if any, is being collected under the authority of subsection 14(1) of *The Personal Health Information Act*.

I acknowledge the following:

- i. I will only be provided with the information to which I am entitled, subject to the availability of the records and any vetoes or preferences on file.
- ii. A search will not be performed for any person who is under 18 years of age or has filed a Disclosure/Contact Veto or Contact Preference for no contact.
- iii. It is my responsibility to inform Manitoba Post-Adoption Services of any future name or contact information changes.
- iv. Manitoba Post-Adoption Services may release my full name, date of birth, city of residence and phone number/email address to my sibling whom I have registered to have contact with should they also register and I cannot be located and I consent to this disclosure of my personal information.
- v. The information provided in this application is true and complete to the best of my knowledge. I certify that I am making this application in good faith and not for any improper purpose.

Guide to Manitoba Post-Adoption Services **Adult Birth Sibling**

The following are the services available to adult birth siblings (18+ years of age) whose sibling's adoption was granted in Manitoba:

Non-identifying Adoptive Family Profile:

- An adult birth sibling is entitled to apply for an Adoptive Family Profile. This is information on the family your sibling joined and regarding your sibling's wellbeing and development prior to the adoption being finalized.
- In compliance with Manitoba Legislation, the Adoptive Family Profile will not contain any identifying information.
- If the Adoptive Family Profile has been previously requested and provided a further copy will be shared.

Registering for Contact/Sharing Identifying Information with your sibling who was placed for adoption:

- An adult birth sibling may register to have contact/share identifying information (i.e. full name, date of birth and contact information) with their adult sibling.
- If your adult sibling also registers to have contact/share identifying information with you, the Registry will facilitate a reunion by assisting both parties in establishing direct contact.
- If you register prior to your sibling being 18+ years of age, you will be notified if their adoptive parents register on their behalf. You will be offered the opportunity to have contact with the adoptive parents.

Requesting Search Services for your sibling who was placed for adoption:

- An adult birth sibling may register to have contact/share identifying information as well as have a search conducted for their adult sibling.
- A search will not be performed for any person who is under 18 years of age or who has filed a Contact/Disclosure Veto or Contact Preference for no contact.
