Table 1 shows the amount of Respite Services (Self Administered Respite, Agency Delivered Respite, Out of Home – Overnight Respite and Respite delivered by Manitoba Department of Families Direct Service Providers) and the amount of In Home Services (Supports to Families and Outreach) for people in each level living in this setting. In Home Services are reserved for individuals with enhanced and complex needs. Individuals using Support Budget Level 1 and 2 are eligible for Respite Services and not eligible for In Home Services.

Table 3 shows approximately how many hours one could expect based on the Support Budget Level and hourly wage.

*Individuals and their families may prefer the flexibility of combining Respite and In Home Services. For example, a family may select Self Administered Respite and In Home Services that are targeted more on skill development and skill acquisition (to develop more independent living skills). This is acceptable as long as the amount does not exceed the total allocation for both Respite and In Home Services.

Table 3 shows the up to amounts that may be available to families caring for a loved one age 18-21 who is attending school and requires support and supervision during summer break. Summer Programming funding is based on the Day Services Funding Model.

Table 4 shows the up to amounts that may be available to families caring for a loved one age 18 to 21 who is attending school to cover school in-service dates throughout the school year. This service is intended to support caregiver employment where no caregiver is available to be at home with the individual and the individual is unable to be alone without support. In-service day up to amounts are calculated at \$15.11 per hour x 8 hours per day x 22 in-service days (including spring break and Christmas break).

Supports Budget Level 1, it is assumed that individuals have the ability to spend time on their own during school in-service days.

The expectation is that parents first use their vacation leave and natural supports (e.g. family members) to support summer and other school closure time. The service that CLDS is offering is based on these other options being explored/exhausted and is within their Supports to People Living with Family Supports Budget. In situations where the family requires additional supports in excess of their supports budget an exceptions review process is to be followed.

Table 5 shows the up to amounts for respite and in home supports as well as up to amounts that may be available to families caring for a loved one age 18 to 21 who is attending school to cover summer break and school in-service dates throughout the school year.
