

Medical Supplies – Information for EIA Participants

You may be eligible for support from EIA if you have prescribed need for a one-time or ongoing medical supply.

EIA can help pay for medical supplies such as (but not limited to);

- Diabetic supplies
- Feeding supplies
- Incontinence supplies/diapers for adults and children with special needs
- Oxygen

If you have coverage through another health services program, you will need to apply to that program for these needs.

Step 1

A Medical Supplies Request and Justification Form will need to be completed by an approved health professional such as your physician, nurse practitioner or an occupational therapist.

The form is available to health professionals through the Electronic Medical Records (EMR) system, or on the EIA website at <http://www.gov.mb.ca/ctt/eia/eiafacts/index.html> or at the Disability and Health Supports Unit website at www.manitoba.ca/fs/dhsu.

The request form must clearly describe that this medical supply is needed due to your health condition. It must also include the length of time this medical supply need will be required.

Step 2
