2020/21	Major	Resident of PCH spilled hot soup on self, sustaining second degree burns to thigh; remained in PCH with ongoing wound assessment and treatment.
2020/21 [Death	Client death as a result of respiratory failure as earlier treatment and intervention may have resulted in a different outcome for this client.
2020/21 [Death	Following a choking episode resident deteriorated and passed away.
2020/21	Major	Client attempted suicide resulting in serious harm. The client remained in care recovering from injury.
2020/21	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and treatment. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2020/21 [Death	Patient suicide while under the provision of healthcare services.
2020/21	Major	An intravenous medication was unintentionally administered outside of a patient's vein. The opportunity for ongoing assessment of the patient's response was not realized.
2020/21	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and treatment. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2020/21	Major	A resident's condition changed. There was a missed opportunity to investigate the deterioration and provide transfer to a higher level of care.
2020/21 [Death	Following a complex surgery there was a delay in recognition and response to a serious complication.
2020/21	Major	An attempted visit with a Home Care client was unsuccessful. The opportunity to activate all client follow up protocols was not realized. The client's condition deteriorated resulting in hospitalization and critical intervention.
2020/21 [Death	A patient, with an acute medical condition, experienced delays in recognition of deterioration and transfer to a higher level of care.
2020/21	Major	A resident experienced skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to intervene were not consistently realized.
2020/21	Major	A patient experienced equipment-related skin tissue breakdown requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.
2020/21	Major	A patient presented to the ER with an acute medical condition. While care was provided the opportunity for further monitoring and consultation with additional experts for treatment planning did not occur.
2020/21 [Death	Resident choked while eating and despite intervention and resuscitation, resident deceased.
2020/21	Major	A patient experienced complications after the removal of a medical device. Early opportunities to intervene were not realized.
2020/21 N	Major	A patient required readmission to hospital to remove a retained surgical item.
2020/21 N	Major	Client's wounds deteriorated resulting in an amputation.
2020/21	Major	A tissue sample was inadvertently discarded complicating diagnosis and treatment planning.
2020/21	Major	A patient experienced skin tissue breakdown related to a medical device requiring increased care and intervention. Early opportunities to provide intervention were not consistently realized.

2020/21	Major	An opportunity for earlier diagnosis and intervention was not realized. The patient deteriorated and required a return to hospital.
2020/21	Major	During removal of a surgical drain, part of the drain apparatus snapped off and was retained in the client. Client underwent surgical intervention to remove retained drain.
2020/21	Death	A patient experienced a delay in diagnostic testing and intervention resulting in an acute deterioration and transfer to a higher level of care.
2020/21	Major	A patient experienced a preventable post-op complication requiring additional intervention.
