2025/26	Major	A patient required escalation of care after receiving a prescribed medication.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced an acute change in their medical condition after receiving a medication. Opportunities to support consistent medication practices were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A resident experienced an injury associated with the use of transfer equipment. Opportunities to support the safe use of assistive equipment were not fully realized.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced an unintended injury and required urgent intervention. Opportunities to mitigate the risk of injury were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced an unintended injury and required urgent intervention. Opportunities to mitigate the risk of injury were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	There were missed opportunities to recognize and provide treatment for an acute medical condition. The patient experienced a deterioration in their health status requiring transfer to a higher level of care.
2025/26	Major	A resident experienced a fall when equipment did not function as intended, resulting in an injury.
2025/26	Death	A resident experienced an acute change in their medical condition. Opportunities for earlier recognition and intervention were not fully realized.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced serious self-harm after accessing healthcare services. Opportunities for earlier assessment and treatment were not fully in place.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a clinical deterioration in their medical condition that required emergency surgery. Opportunities for monitoring and earlier intervention were not realized.
2025/26	Death	A patient in acute condition experienced delays in accessing care. Opportunities for earlier treatment were not realized.
2025/26	Major	A resident experienced skin tissue breakdown. Opportunities to provide earlier interventions to mitigate the risk were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a delay in diagnosis and treatment of an acute medical condition, requiring extension of hospital stay and transfer to a higher level of care.
2025/26	Major	A patient with a medical condition experienced a serious harm during a gap in monitoring.
2025/26	Major	During a transfer, a patient sustained an injury that required additional treatment and extended hospital stay.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced an unintended injury resulting from an interaction with another patient. Opportunities for earlier assessment and intervention were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced an unintended and unexplained outcome after receiving a discharge medication, resulting in an unplanned readmission to hospital.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced a significant change in their medical condition. Opportunities to recognize and respond in a timely manner were not realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a delay in diagnosis of a serious medical condition resulting in harm.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced an unexplained escalation of care after receiving a prescribed medication.
2025/26	Major	There were missed opportunities to review diagnostic tests resulting in delayed recognition of an acute medical condition.
2025/26	Major	A patient developed a pressure injury while in care. Opportunities for wound assessment and care were not fully realized.
2025/26	Death	A delay in response resulted in a missed opportunity for earlier intervention.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a delay in treatment of an acute medical condition leading to an escalation of care.
2025/26	Major	A resident experienced wound deterioration. Opportunities for wound assessment and care were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A resident experienced an injury while in care. Opportunities to mitigate the risk of injury were not fully realized.

2025/26	Major	A patient experienced clinical deterioration while in care. Opportunities for monitoring and intervention were not fully realized.
