

## Critical Incidents Reported to Manitoba Health, Seniors and Long-Term Care

Fiscal Yr Occurred	Degree of Injury	Description
2025/26	Major	A patient did not receive a prescribed medication and experienced a decline in health status requiring intervention and an extended hospital stay.
2025/26	Major	A client experienced a fall that resulted in a serious injury. The client remains in care.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced a delay in treatment of an acute medical condition. Opportunities for earlier recognition and intervention were not realized.
2025/26	Major	There were missed opportunities for earlier diagnosis of an acute medical condition. The patient required an alternate care plan.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced an acute change in their medical condition resulting in death. Opportunities for escalation of care were not realized.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced a delay in accessing a higher level of care and later died. Opportunities for timely transfer were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a fall following an interaction with another patient, resulting in a fracture. Opportunities to implement fall prevention measures were not realized.
2025/26	Death	A resident experienced a fall resulting in a fracture and later died. Opportunities to prevent the fall were not realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced gaps in reporting and assessment, which contributed to a delay in care following an acute medical event.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced a change in their medical condition resulting in death. Opportunities for earlier recognition and intervention were not realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced clinical deterioration requiring an urgent transfer to a higher level of care. Opportunities for earlier intervention and treatment were not recognized.
2025/26	Death	A patient experienced a delay in recognition of and response to their medical condition. The opportunity to activate all follow-up protocols was not realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced serious self-harm. The opportunity to mitigate the risk was not recognized.
2025/26	Major	A resident experienced a fall resulting in a fracture. The motion monitoring device did not activate.
2025/26	Death	A patient presented for assessment and was discharged. The patient later experienced clinical deterioration requiring critical care and subsequently died. Opportunities for earlier recognition and intervention were not realized.
2025/26	Major	There were missed opportunities to recognize and provide treatment for an acute medical condition. The patient experienced a deterioration in their health status requiring transfer to a higher level of care.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a change in their health status following a medical procedure that resulted in an extended hospital stay.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced an injury. Opportunities to mitigate the risk of harm were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced an injury requiring emergent intervention. Opportunities to mitigate the risk were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A client sustained a fracture while in care. Opportunities for earlier recognition were not realized.
2025/26	Death	A resident experienced clinical deterioration. Opportunities for earlier recognition and intervention were not realized.

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2025/26	Major	A patient experienced clinical deterioration. Opportunities for earlier recognition and intervention were not realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a medication error requiring an escalation of care and an extended hospital stay. Opportunities for earlier recognition and intervention were not fully realized.
2025/26	Major	A client experienced a delay in recognition and response to their medical condition. Opportunities to activate all client follow-up protocols were not realized.
2025/26	Major	A patient experienced a delay in referral for treatment of an acute medical condition. Opportunities for earlier intervention were not realized.

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
