# **Claims Submission Procedure - List of Oral Oncology Drugs Dispensed at CancerCare Manitoba**

***Effective August 1, 2018***

**Please include this Procedure in your Drug Programs Information Network (DPIN) Manual under Section 4: Claims Submission.**

- The Home Cancer Drug (HCD) Program was established on April 19, 2012 and provides Manitobans diagnosed with cancer access to eligible outpatient oral cancer and specific supportive drugs listed on the HCD Program Drug Benefits List - at no cost.
- Due to the complexities associated with some oral oncology drugs (i.e. those with Health Canada Requirements, those with narrow therapeutic indexes etc.) CancerCare Manitoba will be solely responsible for dispensing drugs noted on the List of Oral Oncology Drugs Dispensed at CancerCare Manitoba which can be found here: <http://www.gov.mb.ca/health/pharmacare/healthprofessionals.html>

### **INTERIM PERIOD**

An interim period will be in place for the next 90 days. During this period:

- Pharmacy Vendors will have an opportunity to sell through stock purchased.
- Pharmacy Vendors should dispense only their “on-hand” inventory and not re-order.
- If a client’s entire prescription cannot be filled with the “on hand” inventory, the client should receive what the pharmacy has on-hand, the balance of the prescription should be communicated to the CancerCare Manitoba pharmacy at (204) 787-4591 and they can have a new prescription issued for the balance.
- Pharmacies holding high volumes (i.e. 90 days or more) of oral oncology drugs listed on the List of Oral Oncology Drugs Dispensed at CancerCare Manitoba should:
  - Seek to return product in a manner consistent with existing return policies, and depending on the contract or service arrangement between the pharmacy and the distributor, there may be a restocking fee associated with returns and pharmacies are reminded to check with their distributor(s) for more information.
