Re: Prescriber Information Requirement in HIV PEP and STI Drug Order Forms

To better comply with *The Manitoba Pharmaceutical Regulations*, please be advised that effective **February 4, 2019**, the following information must appear at the bottom of the **HIV Post-exposure Prophylaxis Drug Order Form** and the **STI Medication Order Form** before they can be filled by Taché Pharmacy:

Name of the ordering health care professional (“prescriber”)
Signature of the ordering health care professional
Professional license number

*NOTE: If any orders are placed on or after February 4, 2019, without the aforementioned prescriber information on the order form, you will be asked to resubmit. **To avoid delays, please ensure to complete the prescriber information.***
