- Detailed description of Community and Volunteer Services roles and activities during the past three years showing how many hours you volunteered monthly

### Graduate students must also provide:

- Resumé
- Description of academic interests

- Sign and date your application in the appropriate spaces

**Deadline for Applications is September 30th of each year.**

Incomplete applications and applications received after September 30 of each year will not be considered for selection for that academic year. You are then encouraged to re-apply for the next academic year.
