

# Equity Co-op Home **Ownership Program**

**Creating Unique Co-op Housing Opportunities in Manitoba**

Families with low to moderate income may be eligible to buy a share in an affordable housing co-operative (co-op) in selected urban communities, through the Equity Co-op Home Ownership Program.

### **Co-op Housing**

A housing co-op is an organization that provides housing for its resident members.

As part owners of the co-op, members have a say in making decisions that affect their home and housing community.

#### Shared Equity Co-op Housing

Shared equity co-ops allow for members of the co-op to share in responsibilities associated with home ownership and provide an opportunity for households to earn equity.

#### **Co-op Locations**

Some Manitoba Housing owned properties in Winnipeg and other urban areas are being converted to shared equity co-operatives.

The co-ops have two classes of membership - resident and supporting.

#### **Resident Memberships**

Resident members **live in** a housing unit. are obligated to pay a share of operating expenses, and are entitled to a share of any increased equity that the co-op may generate over time. Resident members purchase a share that entitles them to a vote in the dayto-day operations of the co-op.

#### **Supporting Memberships**

Supporting members **do not live in** the co-op, but provide professional support to the co-op. They have shares that entitle them to a vote in the day-to-day operating of the co-op. This class of membership includes Manitoba Housing and other groups.

#### **Eligible Households**

You may be eligible to become a resident member through the **Equity Co-op** Home Ownership Programs if:

## **Co-op Living Education**

All gualified applicants are required to participate in co-op living education classes as part of the **Equity Co-op** Home Ownership Program. The classes include personal budgeting, co-op living and home ownership. They take approximately 16 hours to complete and are free.
