♦ Additional Information:

- Place La Charrette is the first publicly owned social housing investment built in Winnipeg in over twenty years. Manitoba Housing staff and Ten Ten participated in an integrated design team process to develop and complete the innovative, universally accessible residences.
- Place La Charrette is comprised of 4 three-bedroom and 2 two-bedroom bungalows, and a four storey apartment building with 31 residences including 6 one-bedroom, 22 two-bedroom and 3 three-bedroom apartments.
- Place La Charrette is heated by a geothermal system providing lower operating costs and reduced greenhouse gases, meeting or exceeding Power Smart standards overall.
- Ten Ten Sinclair Housing Inc. will be managing and operating Place La Charrette under a Sponsor Management Agreement with Manitoba Housing.
- Rents are at Median Market Rent levels for Winnipeg, and rents geared-to-income will be available in fifty percent of the residences.
