

# Manitoba Housing

## Pets

Manitoba Housing recognizes the value and positive impact that pet ownership can bring. The pet policy strives to balance the positive benefits pets offer and the need for responsible pet ownership.

### What is new?

Before bringing a pet into their home, applicants or tenants must have Manitoba Housing approval and sign the Pet Agreement. A tenant must also sign a Pet Agreement before taking someone else's pet into temporary care.

The Pet Agreement provides rules to follow and asks tenants to obey all municipal bylaws. Among other rules, tenants must clean up after their pets, prevent them from making excessive noise and keep them from disturbing other residents.

Manitoba Housing limits the types and numbers of pets allowed. With approval a household may choose only one of the following options:

- one cat
- one dog
- two birds
- one 15 gallon aquarium with fish

The Pet Agreement clearly outlines how violations will be addressed.
