Arrears

A tenant is responsible to pay rent in full every month and on time as stated in the Tenancy Agreement.

However, Manitoba Housing recognizes that tenants may find themselves in circumstances where they fall behind in their financial obligations. When such situations arise, tenants are encouraged to make payment arrangements to avoid falling into arrears.

When a tenant falls behind in rent payments, it is in the best interest for everyone to work toward a solution that will result in a successful tenancy. Manitoba Housing works with the tenant to set up a payment plan to help the tenant get back on track with rental payments and can assist the tenant by providing referrals to budget counseling.
