Over and Under-housed

Manitoba Housing strives to match tenants to units based on household composition, taking into consideration the number, age and gender of all those living in the home.

When the number of household members increases, tenants may be entitled to a home with more bedrooms.

When the number of household members decreases the remaining members may be required to move to a unit with the appropriate number of bedrooms.

Moving tenants to a home with the appropriate number of bedrooms allows Manitoba Housing to meet the demands of the program.

What is new?

Tenants must report any changes to household composition immediately.

Tenants who are over or under housed are moved to a homes with the appropriate number of bedrooms when one becomes available. Manitoba Housing will discuss the needs of the household with the tenant and provide one unit offer based on the information provided.

Exceptional circumstances may allow tenants to remain in their current home. These include when a tenant:

- chooses to remain under-housed
- is over-housed and there is no demand for the unit
- is actively working toward family reunification
