## Tenant Death

In the unfortunate circumstance of a tenants passing, Manitoba Housing staff will carry out their responsibilities in a compassionate and respectful manner.

When a tenant has passed and they were the only occupant, the tenancy will be ended within 30 days to allow for personal belongings to be removed.

When a household member passes away, the remaining household members must continue to be eligible for the program to continue to receive social housing.

Where the household is overhoused due to tenant death, Manitoba Housing allows the remaining household members to stay in the unit for up to 6 months before being moved to an appropriate size unit.
