Smoking

Manitoba Housing is committed to provide a safe and healthy environment for all tenants, workers and visitors.

While the majority of Manitoba Housing properties allow smoking within the rental homes, by prohibiting smoking in designated multi-unit buildings, Manitoba Housing is providing choice in housing and a safe and healthy environment.

Where Manitoba Housing chooses to designate a building as non-smoking, previous agreements are honoured until the tenancy ends.

Conditions outlined in the smoking policy state that smoking is not allowed:

- in a building deemed as non-smoking (some exceptions apply)
- in any common area of any building
- within eight metres of an opening (door, window, balcony)
- near a device that provides oxygen or where a concentration of oxygen is present

Violations of this policy can lead to a termination of tenancy.
