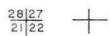

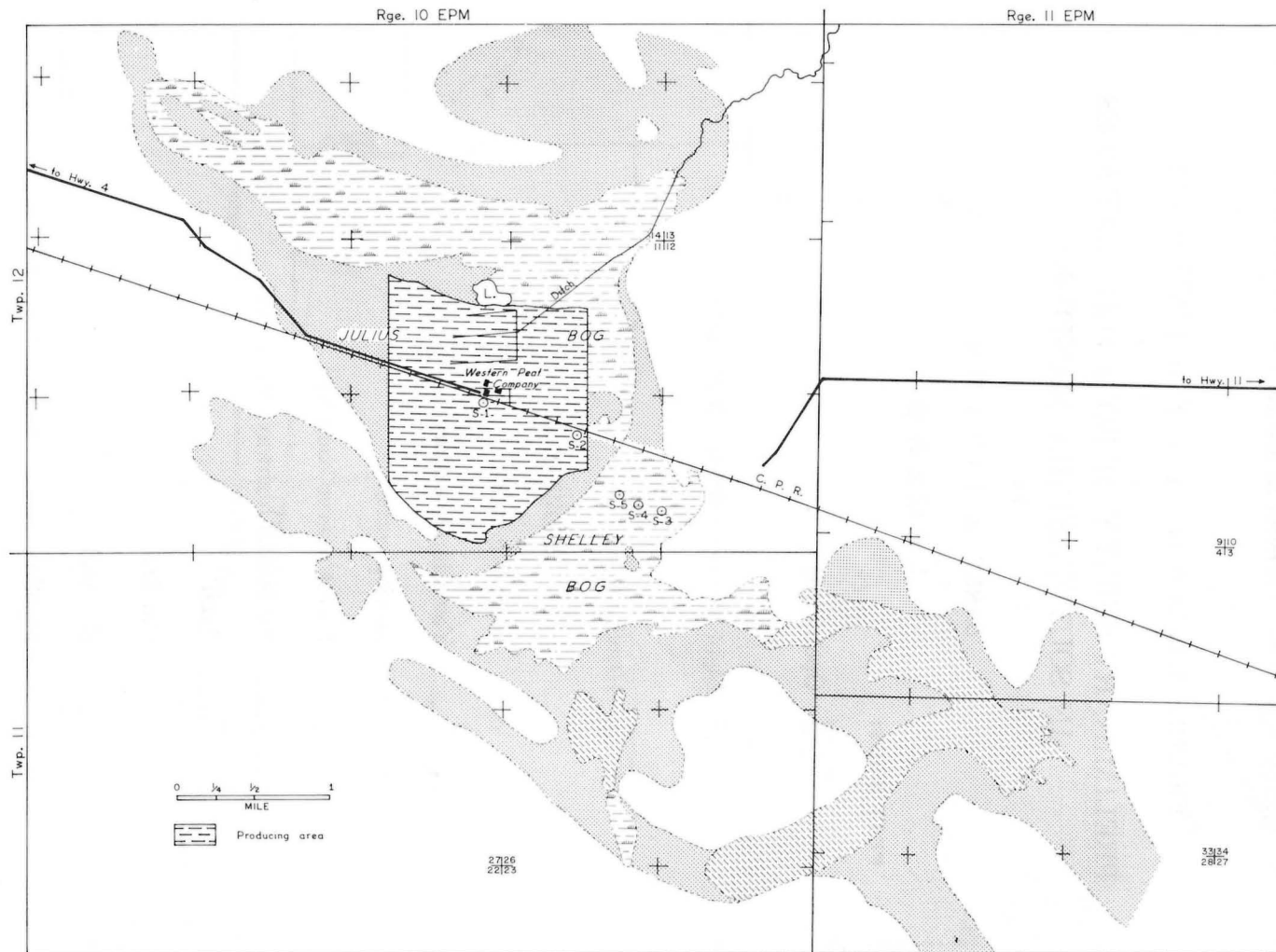


FIGURE 1. Julius and Shelley bogs

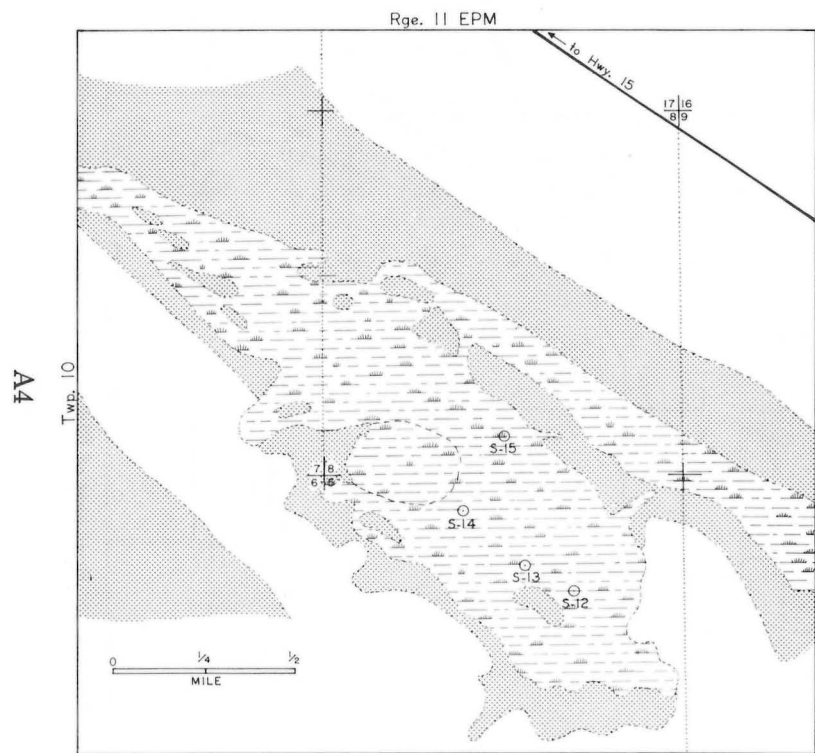


FIGURE 3. Lewis bog

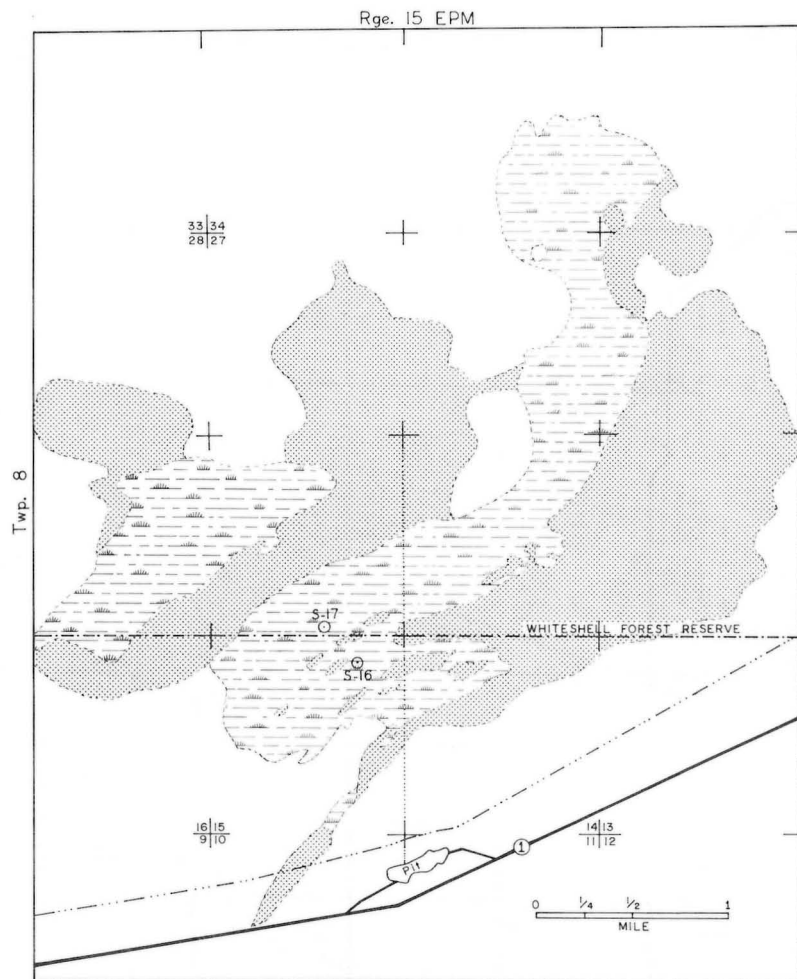


FIGURE 4. Whiteshell bog

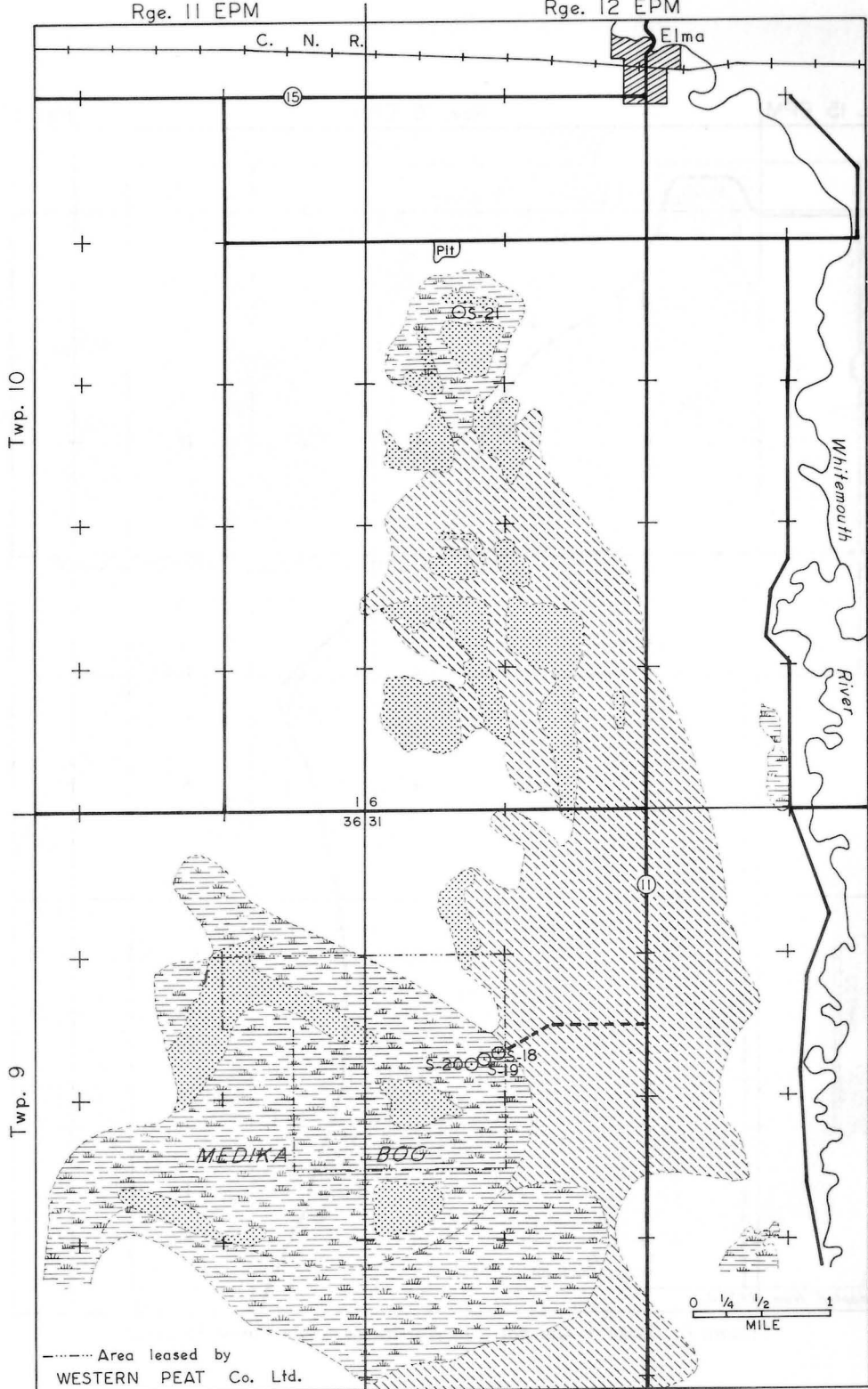


FIGURE 5. Medika bog and bog southwest of Elma

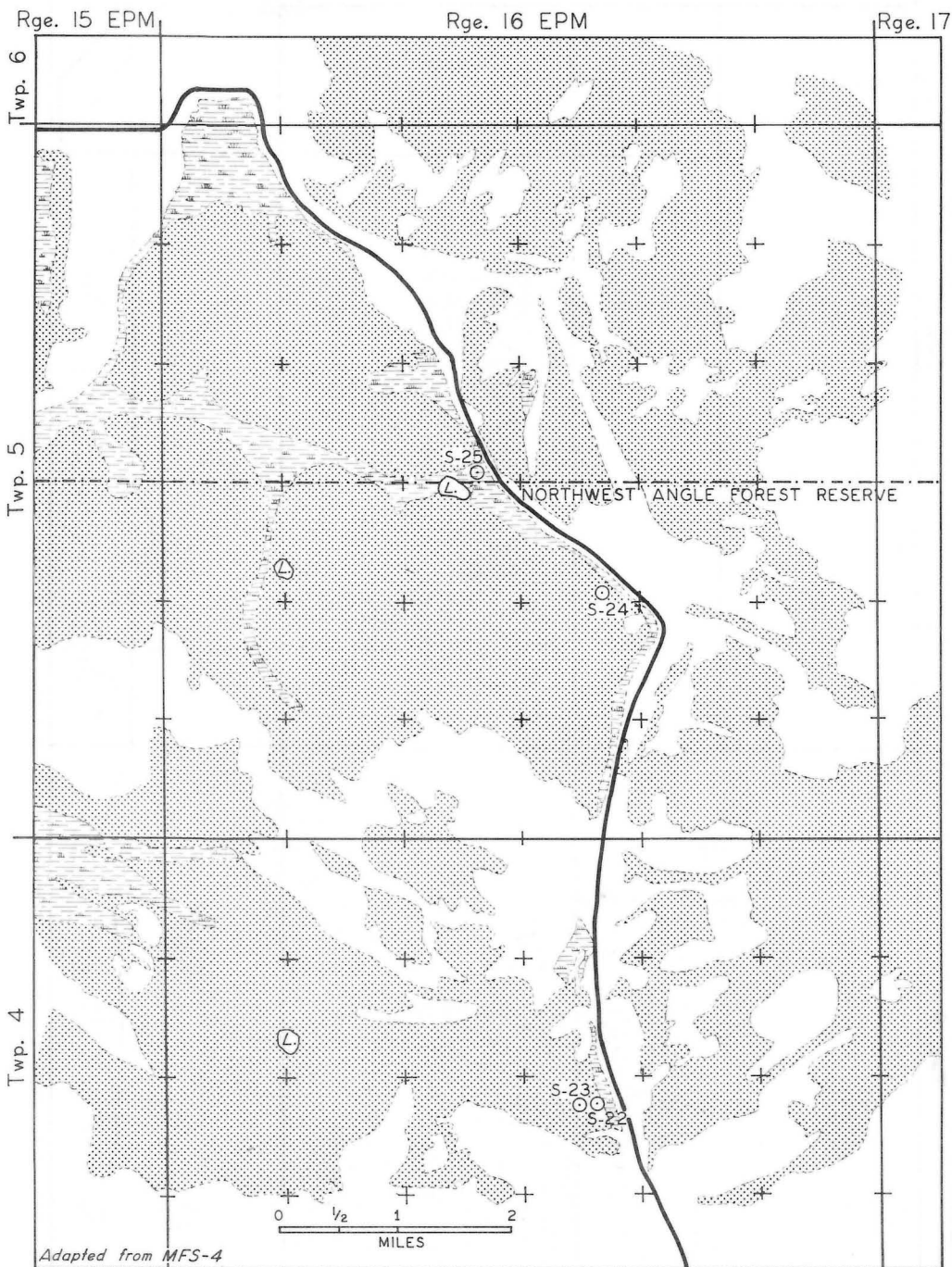


FIGURE 6. Bogs in and north of Northwest Angle Forest Reserve

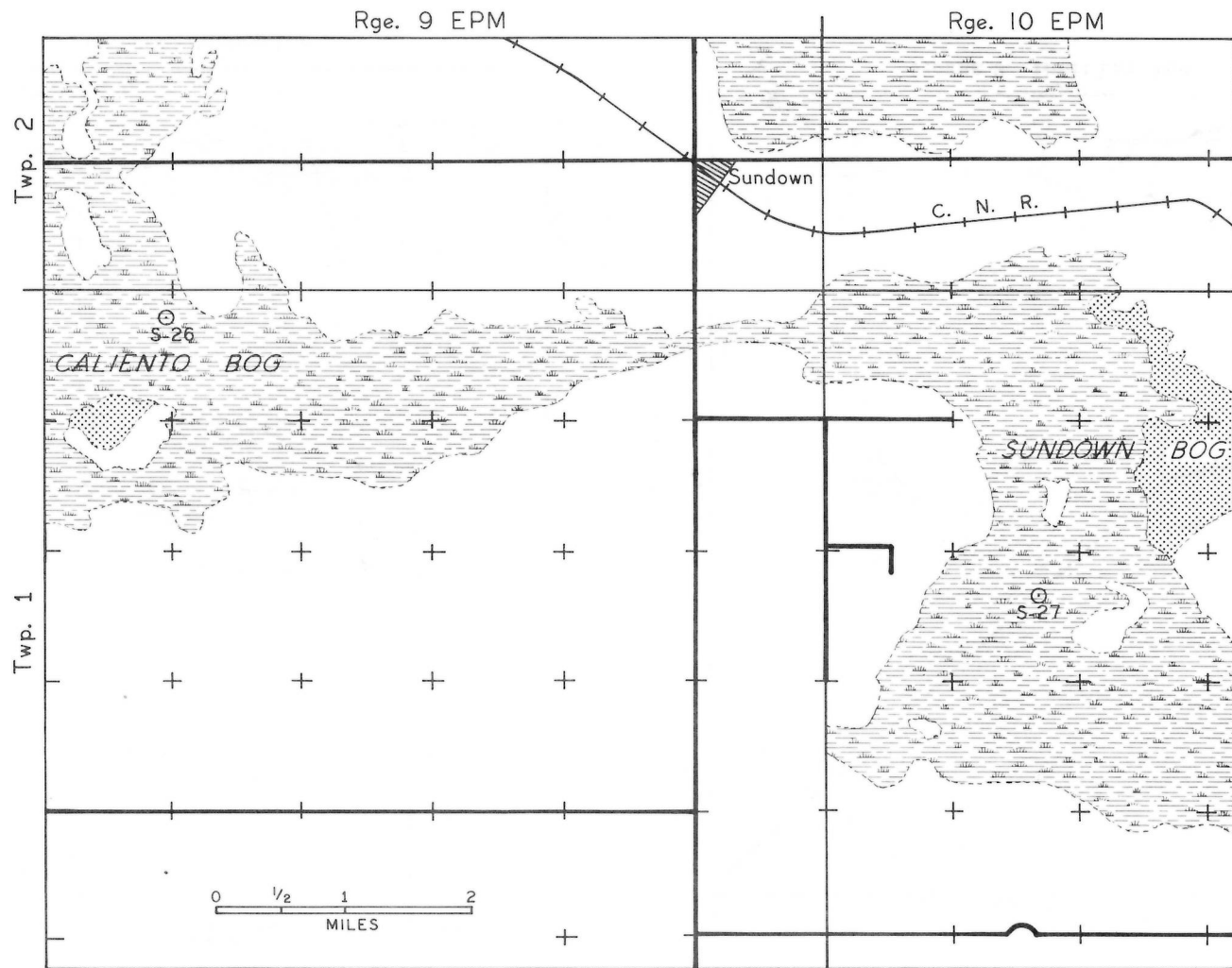


FIGURE 7. Caliento and Sundown bogs

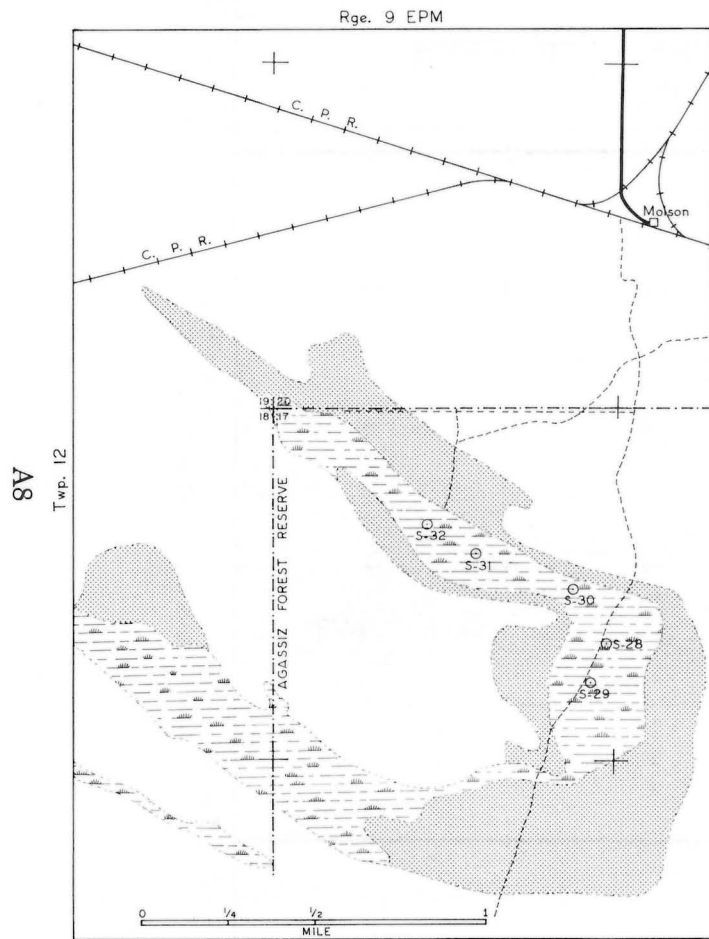


FIGURE 8. Molson bog

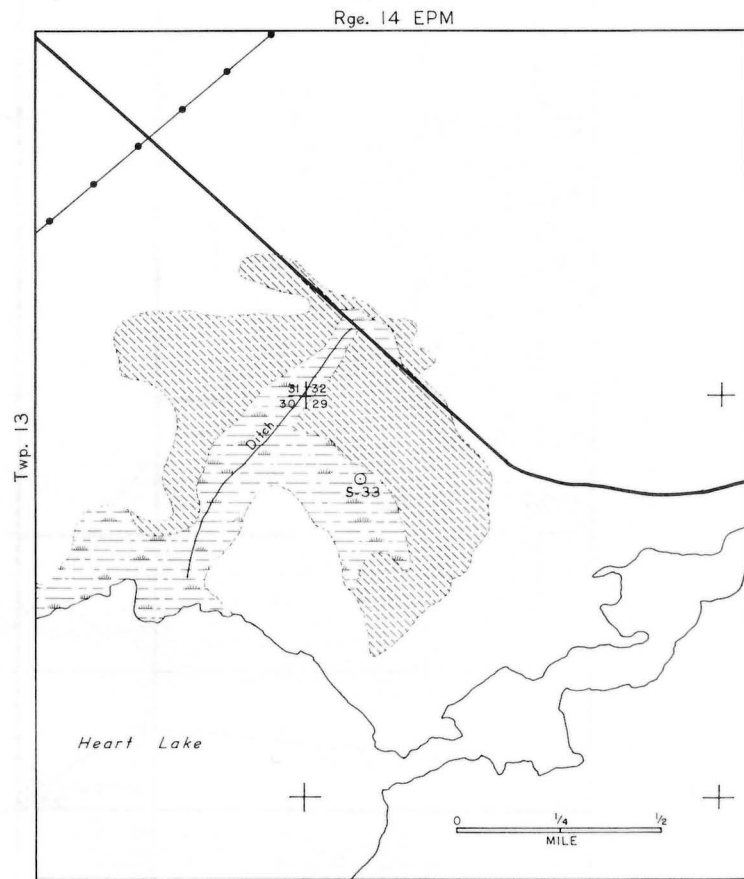


FIGURE 9. Heart Lake bog

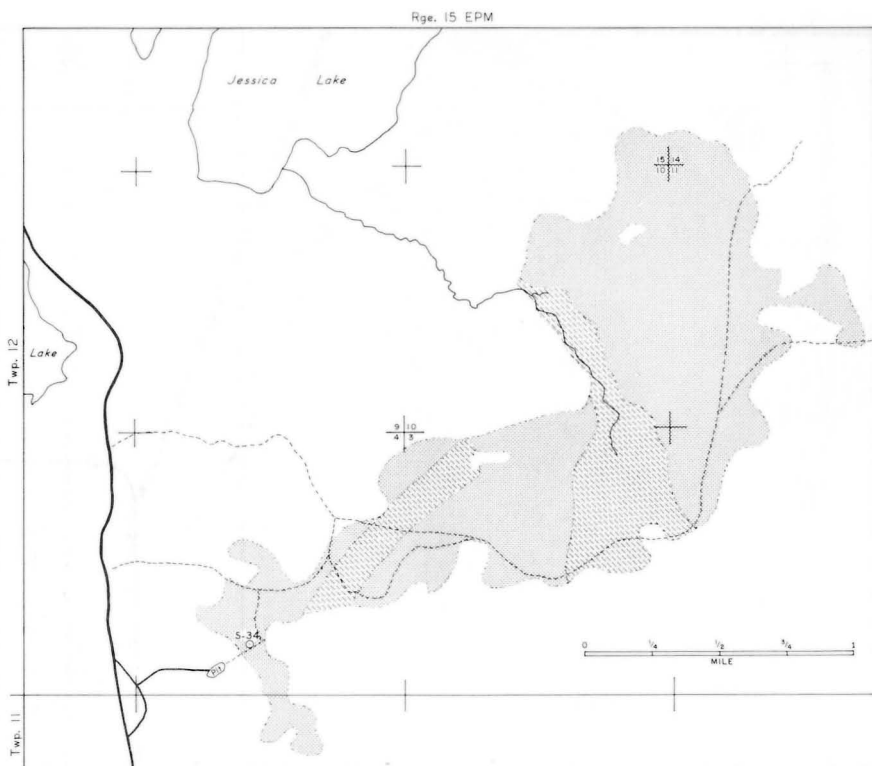


FIGURE 10. Jessica Lake bog

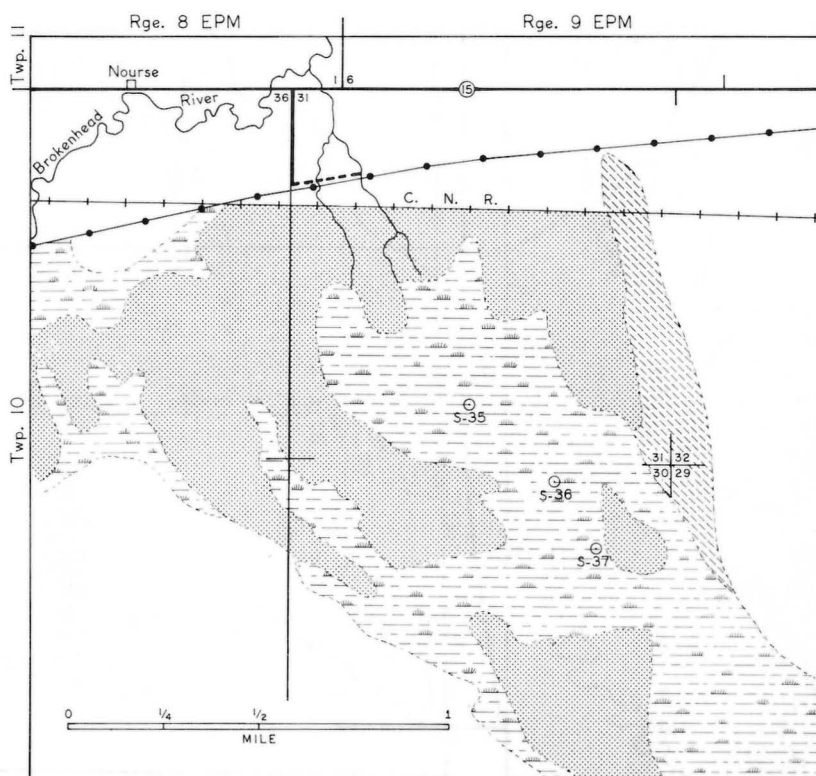


FIGURE 11. Nourse bog

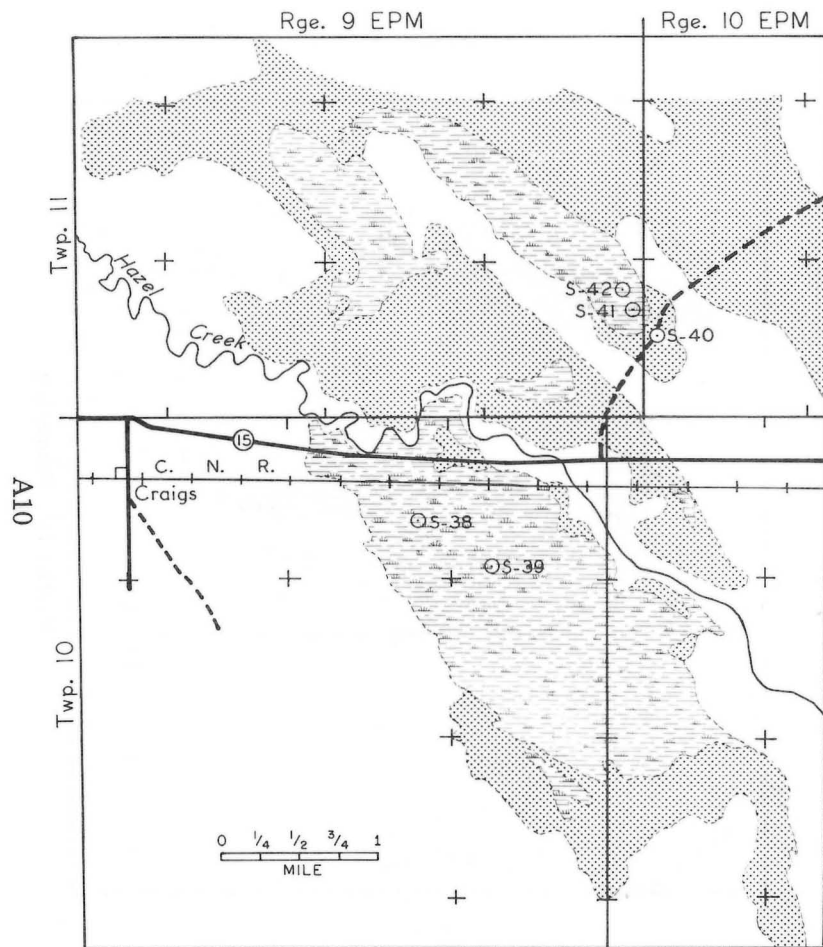


FIGURE 12. Bogs north and south of Hazel Creek

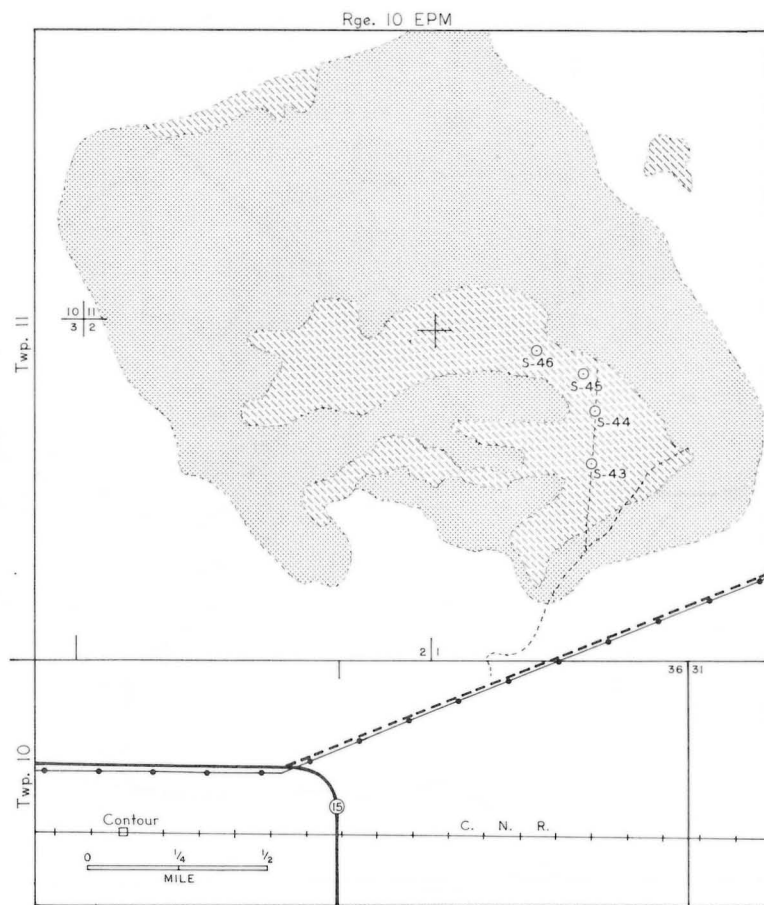


FIGURE 13. Contour bog

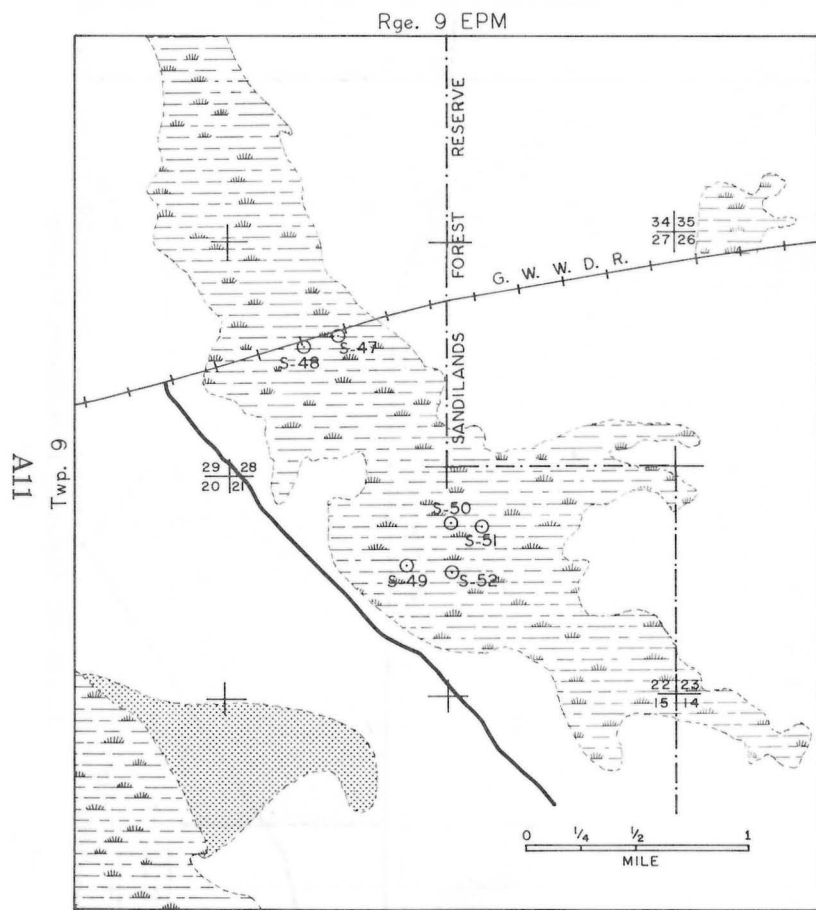


FIGURE 14. Bog east of Ste. Genevieve

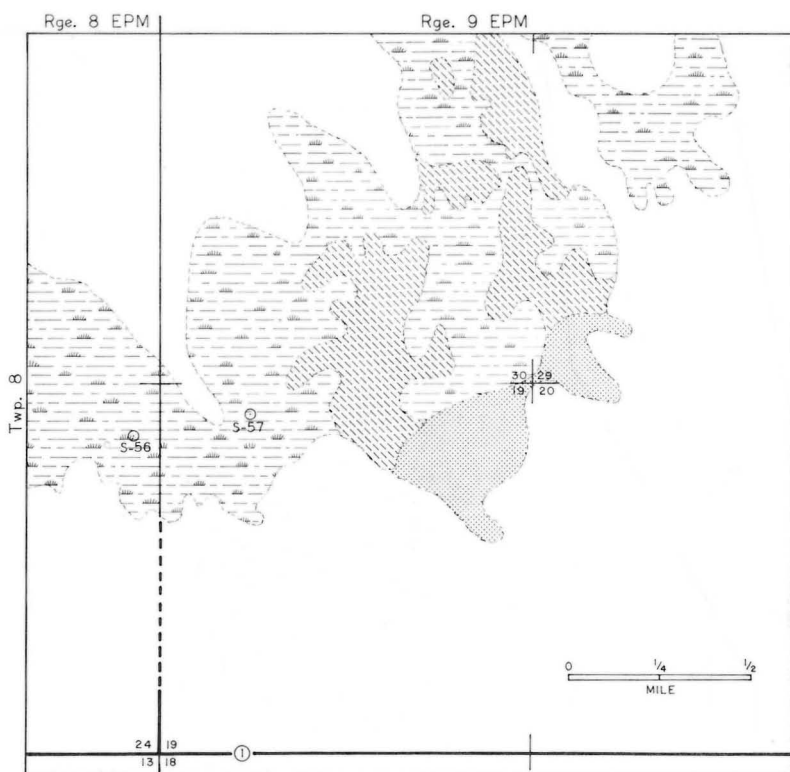


FIGURE 16. Bog northeast of Richer

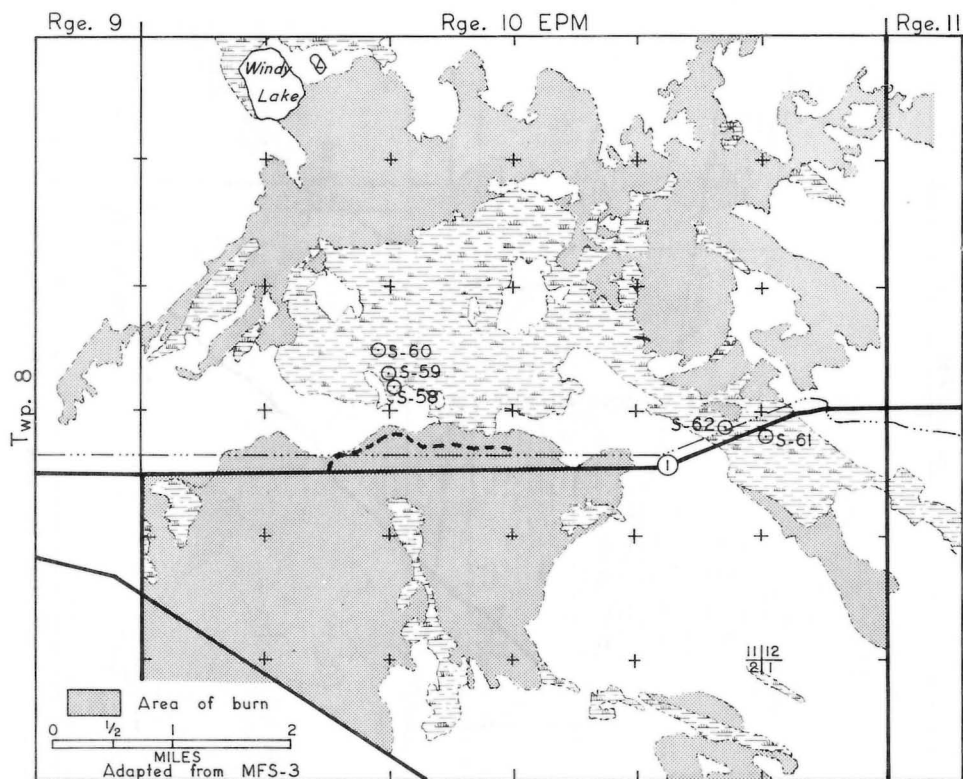


FIGURE 17. Bog along Trans-Canada Highway

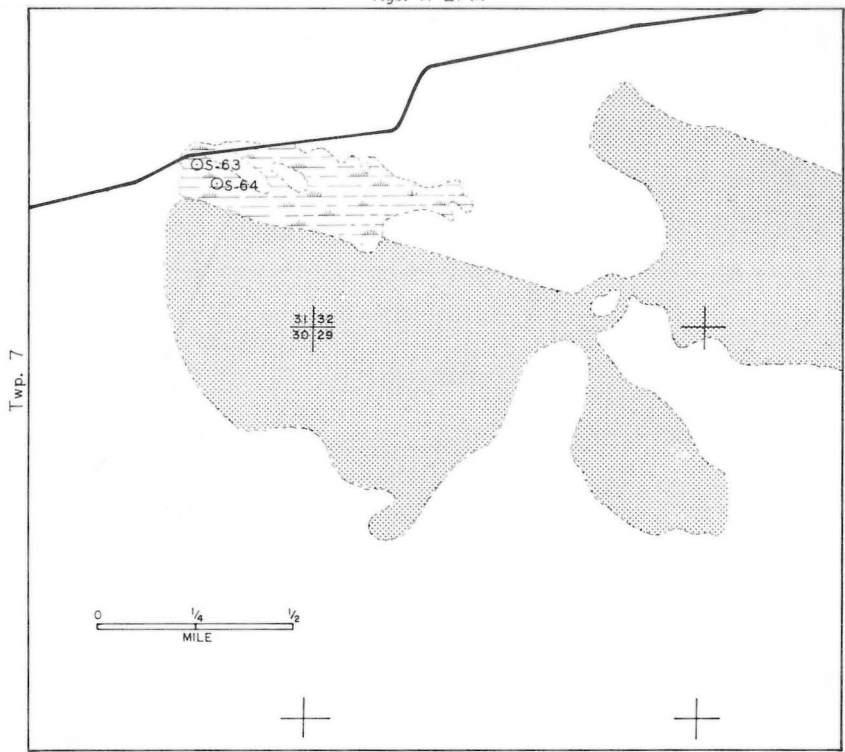
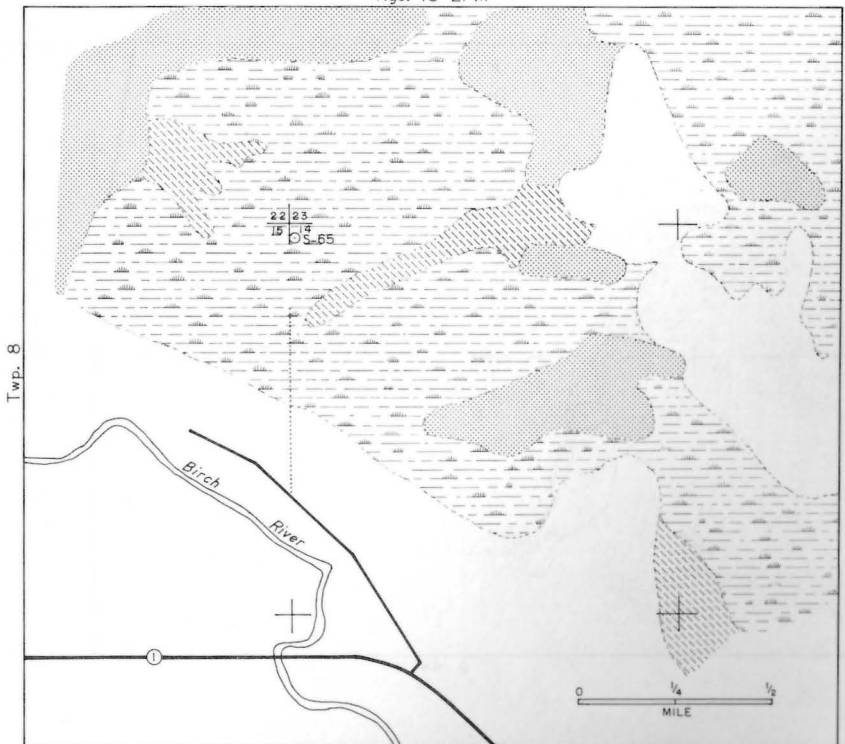


FIGURE 18. Bog southwest of Hadashville

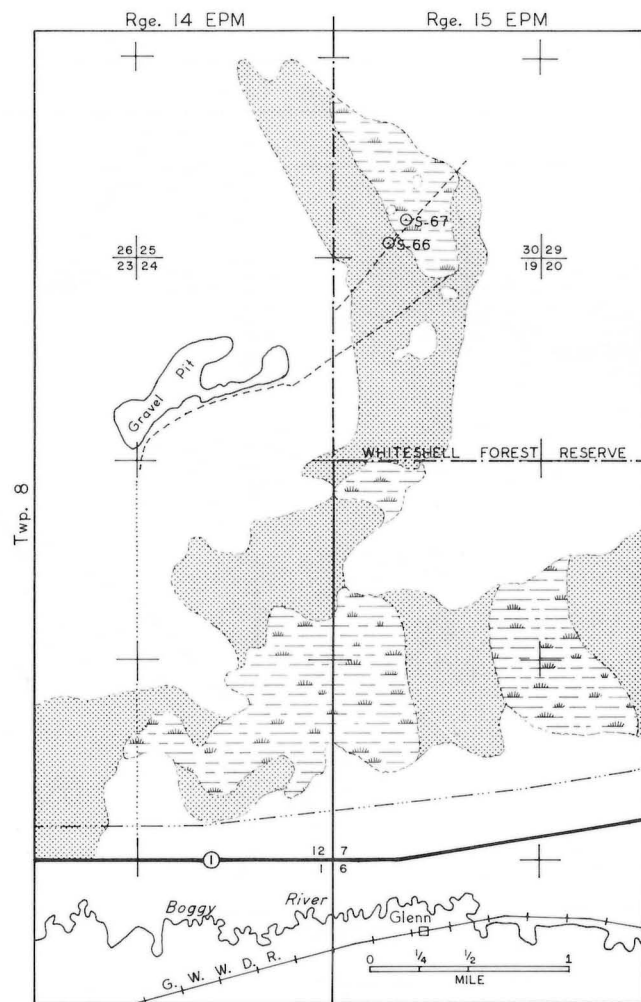


FIGURE 20. Glenn bog

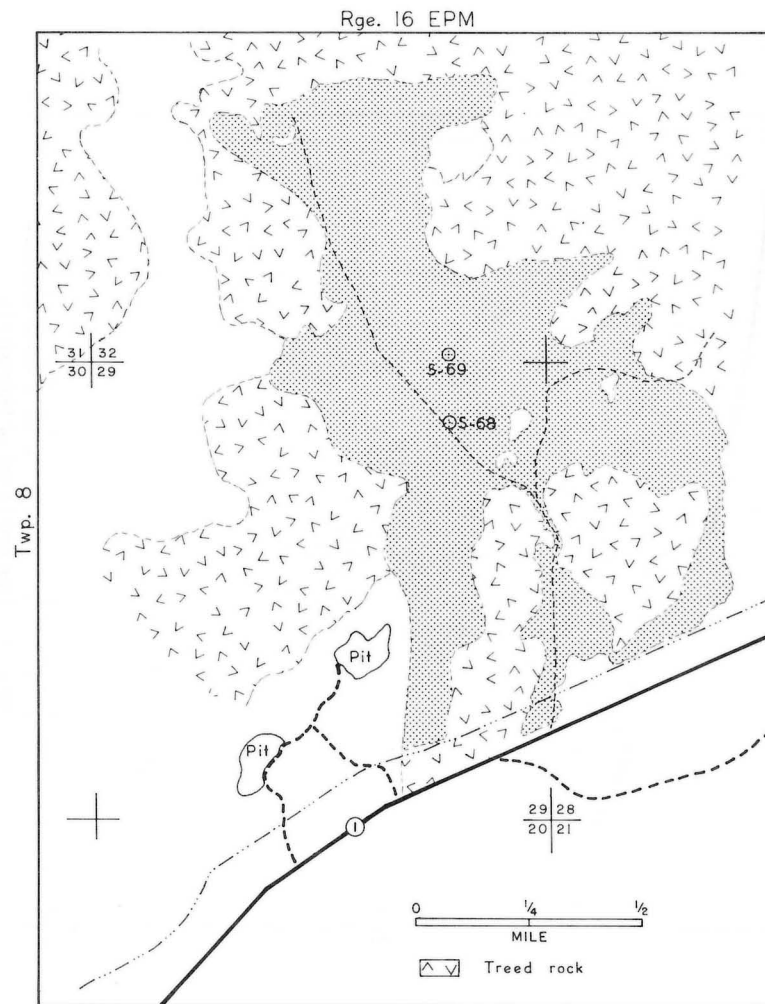


FIGURE 21. Falcon Beach bog

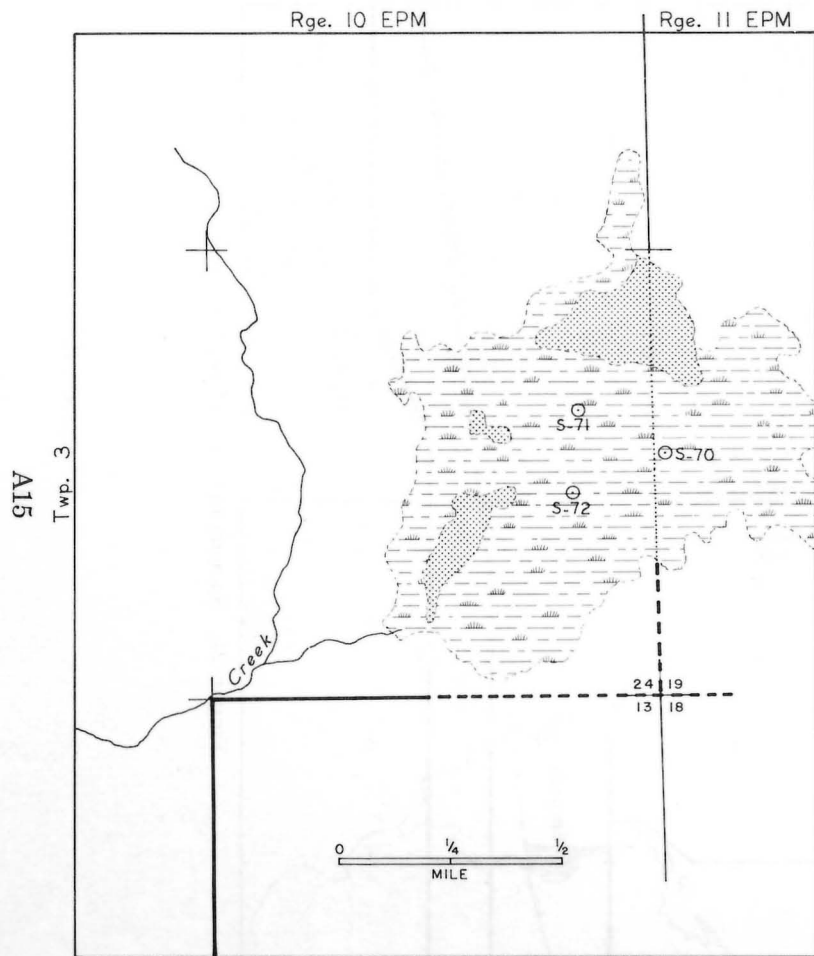


FIGURE 22. Carrick bog

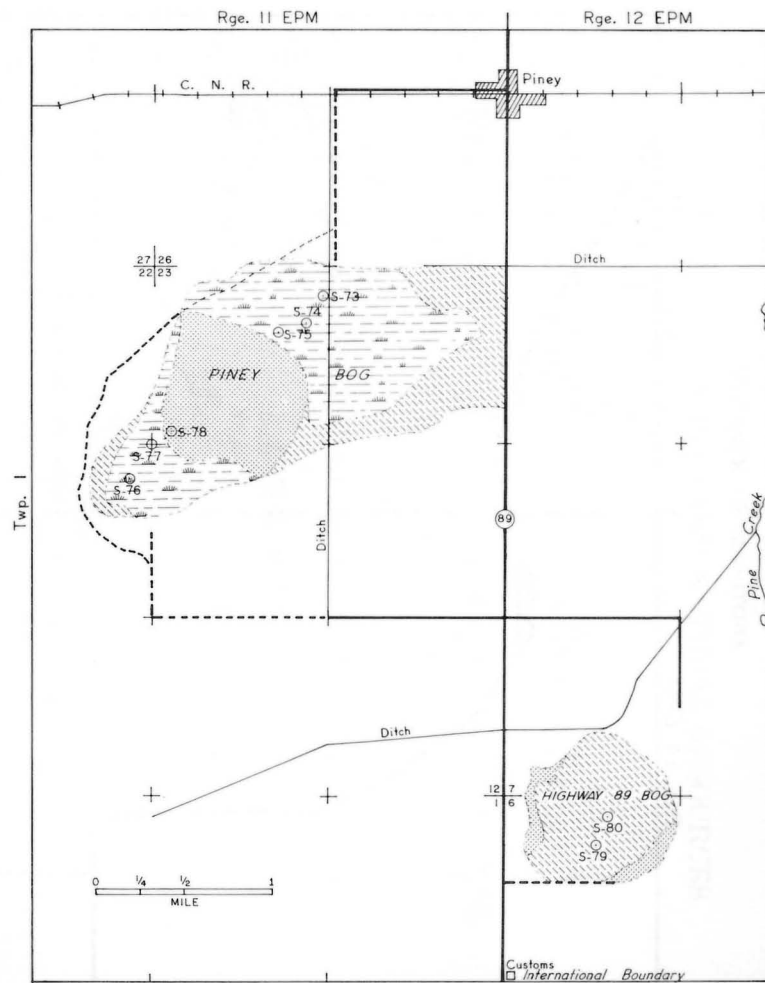


FIGURE 23. Piney bog and bog east of Highway 89

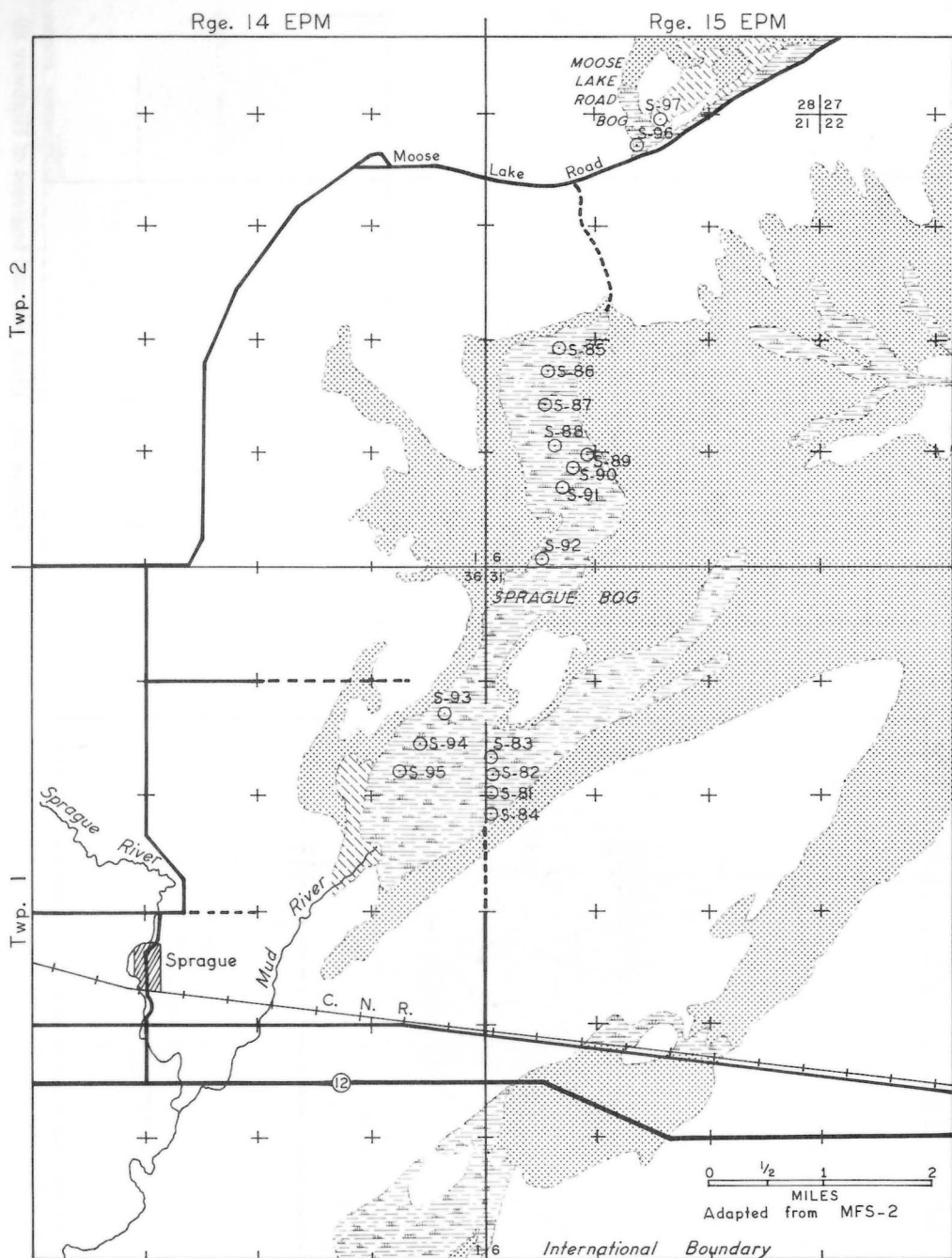




FIGURE 24. Sprague and Moose Lake road bogs


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

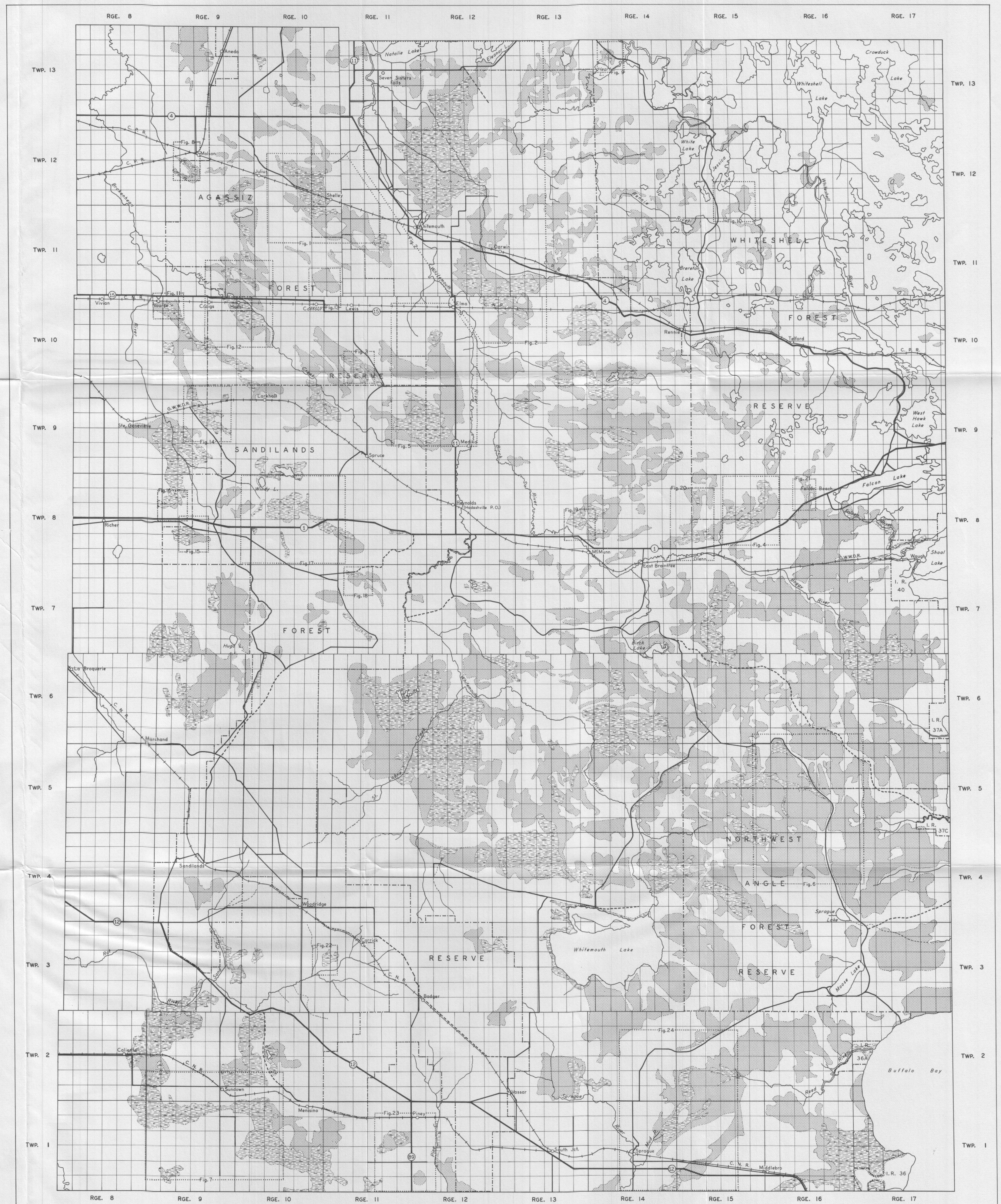
