

INTRODUCTION

The area under investigation, and upon which the expenditures indicated on the attached schedules were incurred, extends from Cape Tatnam on the Mainland of Manitoba, north across Hudsons Bay to Southampton and Coates Islands. The company holds work permits on a significant portion of these areas which includes Cape Tatnam and the southerly portion of the area in the Hudsons Bay.

In order for the company to investigate and to prove up the theory of the geologists, geological examination was required of both the Cape Tatnam area in the south and the Southampton - Coates Islands area in the north.


