Community Status

Aghaming is located on the eastern shore of Lake Winnipeg, roughly 70 kilometers north of Pine Falls. It is one of four communities in a 16 kilometer square area. The Hollow Water First Nation, also known as Wanipigow, lies at the center of this area, with Aghaming to the north-east. Seymourville to the west and Manigotagan to the south-west.

Treated water is supplied from a pumphouse on the Hollow Water Reserve to a standpipe in the community, and to five of the housing units.

Waste Disposal

Provided through use of the Hollow Water Regional Waste Disposal Site. Solid wastes are individual responsibility and liquid wastes transported to the site or to the Seymourville lagoon by private business pump-out truck.

Economic Overview

Economic activity near Aghaming is affected by its location within the Precambrian Shield region of Manitoba, an area of granite-gneissic rock with little or no soil cover. The land within the immediate vicinity of the community is clay with rock outcroppings supporting softwood and hardwood forest cover.

The economic activity in the area includes fishing, hunting and trapping as well as pulpwood logging for the Pine Falls Paper Company Ltd.

Trapping is organized under the Hole River and Lac du Bonnet Registered Trap Line Zones. These trap-line zones are shared with the nearby communities.

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
