Water and Wastewater

Water is currently pumped from Lake Winnipegosis into a 6.3 million litre reservoir by an automatic refill system. It is then treated by

coagulation, filtration and chlorination in the water treatment plant and distributed by piped distribution system. Approximately 178 homes and other facilities are connected to the system. Manual pickup of water from the water treatment plant is available for non-connected customers.

A low-pressure sewage collection system is connected to a three cell lagoon.

Waste Disposal

Garbage pickup is Monday and Thursday. The solid waste disposal site is located 1 km south of the community on PTH 20. This site is supervised and open 16 hours per week.

Schools

Frontier School Division operates two schools in the community. The Philomene Chartrand School located at 203 PTH 20 serves 124 students from Kindergarten to Grade 8. Phone: 204-524 2343. The Minegoziibe Anishinabe School serves 212 students from Nursery to Grade 12. An Adult Education Centre is located at 15 PTH 20 North.
