# **Crane River**

# **Community Overview**

Two communities share the name Crane River, the community and the adjacent reserve. Information in this profile relates to the non-reserve side, unless otherwise noted.

#### Access

The community is located on the west shore at the north end of Lake Manitoba. All-weather access is provided by Provincial Road (PR) 276 from Ste. Rose du Lac to Toutes Aides and PR 481 to Crane River. Dauphin is 120 kilometres (km) to the west and Winnipeg is 320 km to the southeast.

#### Governance

The community was recognized in May 1969 and is represented by a mayor and council under The Northern Affairs Act.

#### Water and Wastewater

Water is pumped twice yearly from Lake Manitoba into a reservoir when there is minimum turbidity. It is then put through and centrifugal filter and a slow sand filter before entering a buffer tank. From there the water runs through a nano filter and UV before being distributed. Manual pick-up of treated water from the plant is available for non-connected customers.

Sewage is piped by a low-pressure system to a lagoon located within the community.

#### Waste Disposal

A solid waste disposal site exists 8 km from the community. It is supervised and open 12 hours per week. The public works employee picks up solid waste once per week.

Lakefront School is operated by Frontier School Division in the community. There is a principal, three teachers and five support staff. The school serves 27 students from Nursery to Grade 8. Phone: 204-732-2750.
