# Fisher Bay

## Community Status

Fisher Bay is on the west shore of Lake Winnipeg and is adjacent to the northern boundary of the Fisher River Indian Reserve (Koostatak), about 215 kilometres north of Winnipeg. PR #224 which passes through the reserve connects Fisher Bay to the provincial highway system.

The community is represented by a mayor and council under *The Northern Affairs Act*.

### Economic Overview

Residents of Fisher Bay engage in commercial fishing on Lake Winnipeg. Fishers use the Catfish Creek, George's Island, Jackhead, Koostatak and McBeth fish stations.

Some income is generated from trapping in open areas which are not part of a Registered Trap Line Zone. A small amount of income is made from seasonal pulp logging.
