
Gods Lake Narrows

Community Status

Two closely related but independent communities share the name of Gods Lake Narrows. One is the Gods Lake Narrows Indian Reserve and the other is the non-treaty community on nearby provincial Crown land. The information in this report relates to the non-treaty community unless noted.

The community is located along the lakeshore of the narrow portion of Gods Lake, about 224 km by air south-east of Thompson and 547 km by air north-east of Winnipeg.

The community has been recognized by Northern Affairs since June 1976, and is governed by a mayor and council under *The Northern Affairs Act*.

Emergency Services

Fire

Fire fighting capability is based on an 8 cylinder Tanker holding 1,000 gallon water supply, hoses and equipment. In addition portable forestry-style equipment is available for grass and brush fires.

Police

Police response is from the Gods Lake Narrows detachment, RCMP – Winnipeg Emergency, phone local (204) 335-2464 and (204) 335-2260.

Medical

Medical response is available from the federal nursing station. It is staffed by two nurses, a dental therapist and two community health workers. A doctor visits weekly on Thursdays to hold a clinic.

Water

Water is pumped from Gods Lake, filtered and chlorinated. Distribution is through a piped water system.

Waste Disposal

Garbage pickup is provided three times a week by contract, and material is disposed of in a solid-waste disposal site near the community.

Sewage collection is piped and pumped to a treatment plant capable of handling 10,000 IGPD.

Schools

Frontier School Division operates the Ministic School in the community. The reserve has its own school. Staff comprise a principal, one teacher and two support staff. Phone (204) 335-2159

Economic Overview

Gods Lake lies within the Precambrian Shield region which is heavily forested and dotted with many small lakes. Whitefish in Gods Lake have been downgraded to "cutters" and are not economical to harvest; therefore, there is no commercial fishing. Relatively small amounts of fish are taken from some of the outlying lakes.

Trapping occurs in the Gods Lake Registered Trap Line Zone.

Local Lodges are providing residents with seasonal guiding jobs.
