Manigotagan was originally founded to provide access to the sawlogs and timber resources in the area. It is one of a group of four closeby that includes Hollow Water reserve, Seymourville and Aghaming.

Manigotagan is situated near the mouth of the Manigotagan River on the east shore of Lake Winnipeg about 70 kilometres north of Powerview-Pine Falls on Provincial Road 304.

The community employs a community administrative officer, public works employee, volunteer fire chief, community safety officer and shares a recreation director.

Economic Overview

The community is located within the Precambrian Shield region of the province, an area of granite-gnessic rock with little or no soil cover. Within the community boundary there is some clay cover, with rock outcrops, supporting soft and hard wood forest cover. Residents work in the production of pulpwood and some sawlogs for private saw mills.

Additional economic activity includes commercial fishing, trapping, hunting, wild rice harvesting and tourism. Fishers deliver their catch to the Wanipigow fish station. Trapping is organized under the Hole River and Lac du Bonnet Registered Trapline Zones. Wild rice planting and harvesting occur along the Manigotagan River to Turtle Lake and surrounding area. Tourism is focused on the Wood'n Bell Motel, English Brook campground and Manigotagan campground facilities. Local guides are available for hunting and fishing groups.

Water and Wastewater

Water is pumped from the Manigotagan River to the treatment plant, receives nanofiltration and is piped to the individual residences. Sewage from ninety per cent of the community is piped to a Sewage Batch Reactor (SBR) plant. The balance is handled by commercial sewage pump-out truck and delivered for treatment to the SBR plant.

A shared regional solid waste disposal site is located between Manigotagan and Seymourville on the reserve.


