# Incorporated Community of Nelson House

---

## Community Status

Two communities share the name Nelson House. One is the Nelson House Indian Reserve, now called the Nisichawayasihk First Nation, while the other is the non-treaty community adjacent to the reserve. All information in this report relates to the non-treaty community unless noted. The community was Incorporated into the Incorporated Community of Nelson House in May 2004.

The community is situated on a bay of the north shore of Footprint Lake approximately 75 km west of Thompson. PR # 391 and a community access road connects the community to Thompson or Leaf Rapids.

The community was built at its present location as a result of the Churchill River Diversion through the Rat River. Residents previously lived on the reserve, but established the community when all the adjustments to diversion plans were taking place.

The community was recognized by the department in July 1974, and is currently governed by a mayor and council under *The Northern Affairs Act*.

## Emergency Services

### Fire

Fire fighting capability is based on a small "fast-attack" vehicle with limited water supply, hoses and equipment. Addition portable forestry-style equipment is available for grass and brush fires.

### **Police**

Police response is from the Thompson detachment, RCMP, phone (204) 677-6909.

### **Medical**

Medical support comes from the federal nursing station on the nearby reserve, which has two nurses, two community health workers, a weekly doctor's clinic and a monthly dental clinic. The nearest hospital is in Thompson.

## **Community-based Services**

### **Hydro**

Provided by Manitoba Hydro as land line electric power. Residential rates are:

### **Telephone**

Manitoba Telecom Services provides individual-line service and digital switching with toll-free calling to Thompson and South Indian Lake. Call MTS toll-free at (204) 225-5687.

### **Water**

Water is pumped from Footprint Lake, filtered and chlorinated. Distribution is through a piped water distribution system.

### **Waste Disposal**

A solid-waste disposal site is located on the reserve and is a joint-use site. Solid-waste is picked up weekly and delivered to the solid-waste site.

Wastewater is collected from holding tanks and hauled to the First Nation Wastewater Lagoon

### **Schools**

Children from the community are transported to the Nelson House Reserve School. There is an agreement between Frontier School Division and the reserve to cover costs.
