Pine Dock is located on the west shore of Lake Winnipeg in the Narrows region of the lake, 16 kilometres south of Matheson Island and historically known as Bullhead on navigation maps. Others nearby include Princess Harbour, Long Body Creek and Loon Straits.

The community is served by Provincial Road 234 which provides road linkage to Riverton and then via Provincial Trunk Highway 8 to Winnipeg.

Water and Wastewater

Water supply is based on a membrane water treatment plant supplied with well water. The water is treated, chlorinated and stored in a reservoir. Approximately 95% of the community is connected to the system. Others may be connected to a specific well or lake intake.

Sewage is treated in a lagoon. Approximately 95% of the residences are connected to the low-pressure collection system. The balance is collected by pump-out truck and hauled to the lagoon.

There is a waste disposal site, along with a limited access pit for controlled liquid wastes.
