### **RE: Lost Digital Camera Memory Card**

A damaged digital camera memory card was found in Kassel, Germany in February 2016 by an employee of the Netherlands Prosecutors Office. Over 400 photographs including those taken at a wedding, grave site, summer vacation, and Christmas 2015 were recovered from it. The Prosecutors Office would like to return the photos to the owners, as in their view many of them are irreplaceable. They have asked Manitoba Justice to assist in identifying the owners of the memory card, whom they believe to be a Canadian family.

Our office is requesting public assistance to identify the individuals in the attached photographs, with the hope that this connection will allow us to contact the owner of the lost memory card. We urge you to share this notice in its entirety with others throughout Canada.
