Community Notification Process

- 1. Federal or Provincial Corrections, Police and/or Community identify high-risk sexual offender.
- 2. Notify Police.
- 3. Police bring case to Committee. Offender notified before Committee deliberates.
- 4. Committee considers written submission from offender. Committee examines information and assess risk.
- 5. Committee Recommendation is either for a full public notification, a limited public notification, targeted notification, no notification, or other measures.
- 6. Police consider the Committee recommendation.
- 7. Police release/do not release information.
