

NOTICE- INTERAC e-TRANSFER PAYMENT FOR PROVINCIAL OFFENCES COURT TICKETS

Effective February 8, 2021 the Government of Manitoba began accepting payments for Provincial Offences tickets by Interac e-Transfer Auto Deposit. Eligible tickets may include photo enforcement and traffic tickets. This allows clients to make payments without having to travel to their nearest court centre. In order to make a payment via Interac e-Transfer, funds must be in Canadian currency and can be received Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., excluding holidays. The maximum amount that can be sent via Interac e-Transfer is based on your client card's daily access limit. You will need to be aware of your limit when sending a payment and request an increased limit from your financial institution if required.

The Auto-Deposit feature will be enabled, therefore a security question and answer is not required. Please note that your financial institution must be an Auto-Deposit participating bank or credit union to use this payment method.

To pay a ticket by Interac e-Transfer, please contact the Provincial Offences Court in Winnipeg by calling 204-948-1282 for further instructions each time prior to making a payment. Failure to do so will result in the ticket(s) being default convicted along with a \$100.00 penalty added to the fine as the Government of Manitoba will be unable to process this payment towards your ticket(s).
