#### IN THE COMMITTEE

In the section of the Committee of Supply sitting in Room 255, on Wednesday May 12, 1999, considering the estimates of the Department of Industry, Trade and Tourism, the Honourable Member for Crescentwood moved a motion to reduce the estimate of the Department of Industry, Trade and Tourism.

That the expenditures of the Department of Industry, Trade and Tourism be reduced by \$5 M specifically, from appropriation 10.2(b) 3(a), and; that this amount be transferred to the Estimates of the Department of Family Services for the purpose of providing to all low income Manitoba families the National Child Benefit Supplement.

This motion was ruled out of order. The ruling of the chair was challenged and was sustained on a voice vote. Whereupon a counted vote was requested and Members sitting in Room 254 and Room 255 returned to the Chamber. A counted vote was held, which sustained the ruling (29-22).

Report was received and the Committee of Supply obtained leave to sit again.

During Oral Questions, Madam Speaker interjected and cautioned the Leader of the Official Opposition with regards to the use of the words "to tell the truth",
