9.3 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding ONE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE MILLION, ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS for FAMILY SERVICES AND HOUSING:

for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2001.

9.4 RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding TWO HUNDRED TWENTY SIX MILLION, THREE HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS for FAMILY SERVICES AND HOUSING:

for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2001. RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding FORTY 9.5 TWO MILLION, ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS for FAMILY SERVICES AND HOUSING: HOUSING \$42,181,200.00 for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2001. RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding FIVE 9.6 MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS for FAMILY SERVICES AND HOUSING: AMORTIZATION OF CAPITAL ASSETS..... \$5,733,100.00 for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2001. RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding TWELVE MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY-ONE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED DOLLARS for **HEALTHY CHILD INITIATIVE:** HEALTHY CHILD INITIATIVE \$12,791,900.00 for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2001. RESOLVED that there be granted to HER MAJESTY a sum not exceeding SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND DOLLARS for HEALTHY CHILD INITIATIVE: AMORTIZATION OF CAPITAL ASSETS..... \$74,000.00 for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 2001. Resolutions were reported. Report was received and the Committee of Supply obtained leave to sit again. Hon.
