The following petitions were presented and read:

Mr. FRIESEN – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to reverse the job-killing PST increase and to restore the right of Manitobans to reject or approve any increases to the PST through a referendum. (S. Froese, L. Unrau, S. Klassen and others)

Mr. EICHLER – Legislative Assembly of Manitoba to urge the Provincial Government to reverse the PST increase and to restore the right of Manitobans to vote in a referendum on increases to the PST. (A. van Solkema, D. Robb, C. Thomas and others)
