Industry

North-West corner of building

Science and Learning

South-West corner of the Building

Three women, each represent a different aspect of the learning process. The two seated women represent learning that can be achieved through exercising one's mind, and using one's hand to create. The woman standing in the middle holds within her right hand the orb of wisdom, while in her left hand she holds the lamp of guidance.



Agriculture

South-East corner of the building

Man and Woman each with arms laden with the bounty offered by mother earth. The man kneeling forward presents a sheaf of wheat while the woman crouched opposite to him carries a basket full of fruit

The first two represent the bounty that nature offers. In the middle, a man stands amid a wheat field holding a scythe in his right hand, he is the symbol of the labour needed to grow and harvest the food necessary for survival.
