## **MANITOBA LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY PUBLIC GALLERY REOPENING**

We are pleased to announce that the Public Gallery of the Manitoba Legislative Building will be reopening on Monday, April 4, 2022.

Each day a limited number of passes will be available on a first come basis from the main entrance at the North Doors of the building.

Visitors are advised that they will be required to undergo security screening as they enter the building. This screening includes scanning and recording of government issued ID and proceeding through a metal detector.

If visitors are attending for Routine Proceedings at 1:30 p.m. (featuring Question Period) they will be escorted upstairs from the main entrance at 1:15p.m. Visitors will then be required to check all coats, bags, cell phones, and any other recording devices. After proceeding through the coat check area visitors will again proceed through a metal detector at the entrance to the Public Gallery.

If visitors are not attending for Routine Proceedings they will be escorted to the Public Gallery as soon as possible upon arrival.

While in the Public Gallery, visitors are expected to adhere to the Gallery Code of Conduct:
