



MANITOBA TRADE UPDATE

SECOND QUARTER, 2025

Manitoba Exports

Between January and June 2025, Manitoba exported \$10.14 billion worth of goods to international markets, down \$312.4 million, or 3.0%, compared to the same period in 2024, when exports reached \$10.45 billion.

Manitoba's exports to the United States (U.S.), which represent 71.6% of the province's total exports, declined by 6.2%. Japan recently became Manitoba's second-largest export destination, accounting for 5.8% of total exports with a 28.1% increase. In contrast, exports to China—Manitoba's third-largest trading partner—declined by 32.0%.

Roughly half of U.S.-bound exports went to Midwestern states, rising 1.9% to \$3.54 billion. In contrast, exports to Southwestern states dropped by 22.4% to \$1.42 billion, mainly due to lower pharmaceutical shipments to Tennessee.

Agriculture exports totalled \$2.26 billion in 2025, up 6.4% from last year. Growth was driven by increases in Rape/colza seeds (up \$98.0 million or 23.6%), Wheat (up \$60.7 million or 7.2%), and Live swine (up \$18.6 million or 15.6%).

In 2025, manufactured exports fell 4.5% to \$6.98 billion. Pork exports rose 10.8% to \$780.8 million, driven by strong demand from Japan. Public transport vehicles saw significant growth of 42.8%, reaching \$429.0 million, as bus manufacturers responded to U.S. demand. Conversely, exports of packaged medicines declined by 28.0% to \$798.4 million, driven by reduced imports from the U.S.

Manitoba Imports

From January to June 2025, Manitoba imported \$17.54 billion worth of goods, up \$1.46 billion over last year, marking a 9.0% increase in international purchases.

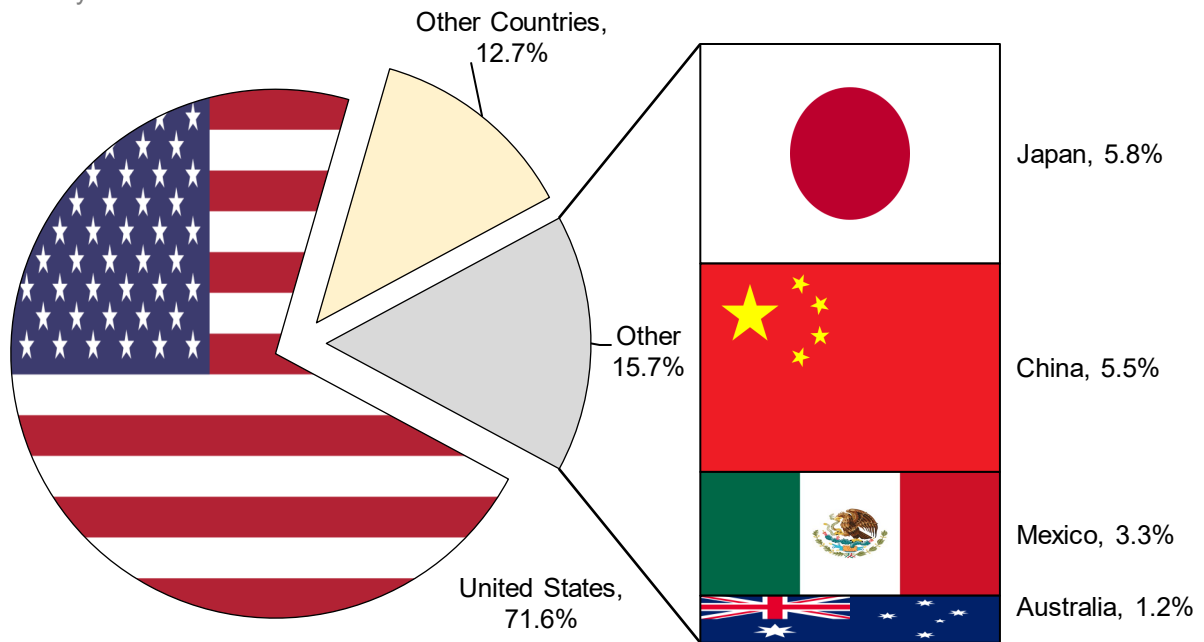
U.S. imports grew by 9.0% year-to-date, reaching \$13.17 billion and accounting for 76.4% of Manitoba's total imports in 2025. Mexico remained the second-largest import partner with a 7.1% increase to \$837.7 million, representing 4.9% of total imports. Imports from China rose by 3.8% to \$834.7 million, making it Manitoba's third-largest source of imports.

Nearly 60% of Manitoba's imports from the U.S. originate from Midwestern states, which saw a 16.3% year-to-date increase, reaching \$7.89 billion.

As of June 2025, Manitoba's manufactured goods imports rose 11.3% year-to-date to \$16.72 billion, making up over 95% of all international imports. Key drivers included Refined Petroleum & Coal Oils (Non-Crude) (up 799.0% to \$1.72 billion), Gas turbines (up 56.1% to \$919.5 million), and Agricultural machinery (down 5.5% to \$744.2 million).

Manitoba domestic exports by selected countries, share (%)

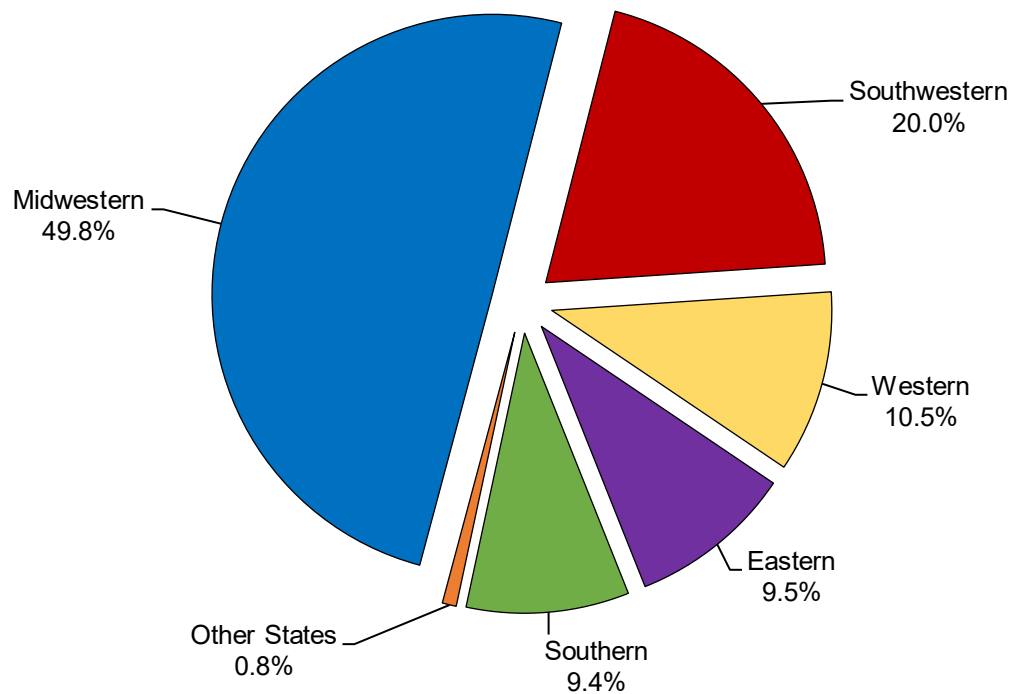
January to June 2025

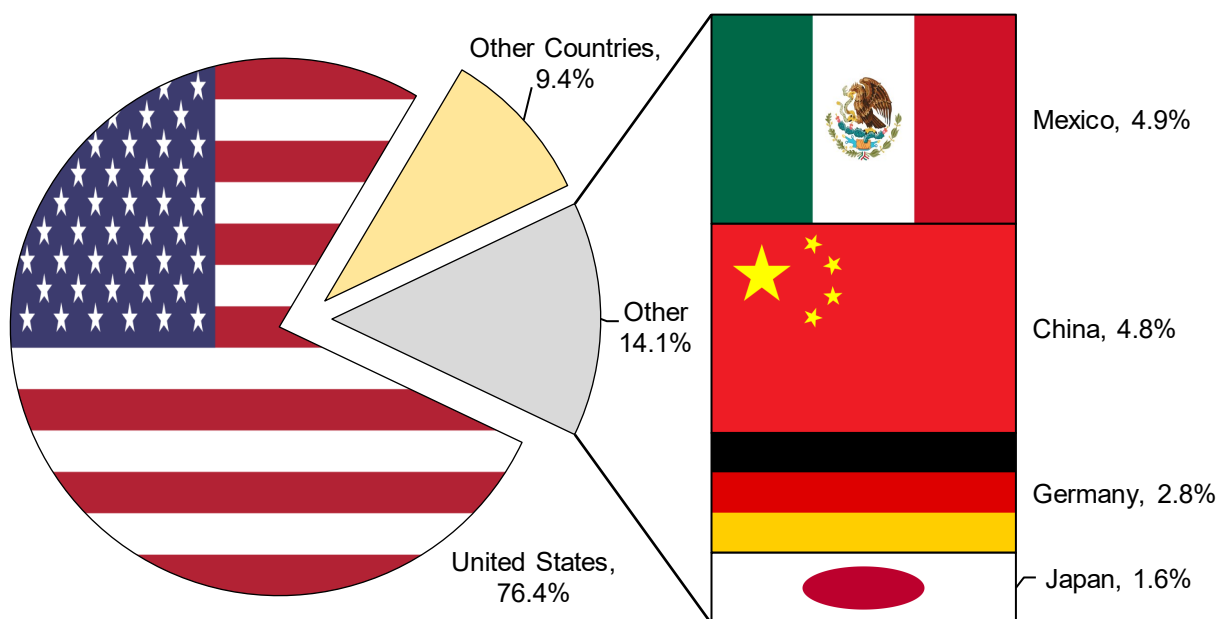

Manitoba imports by selected countries, share (%)

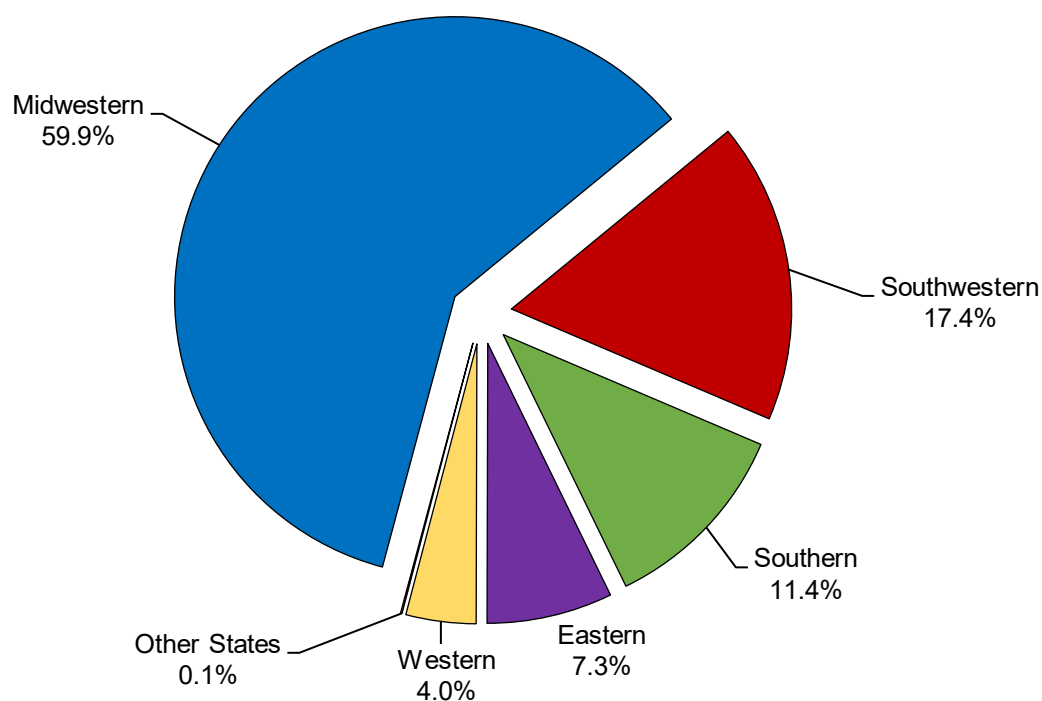
January to June 2025

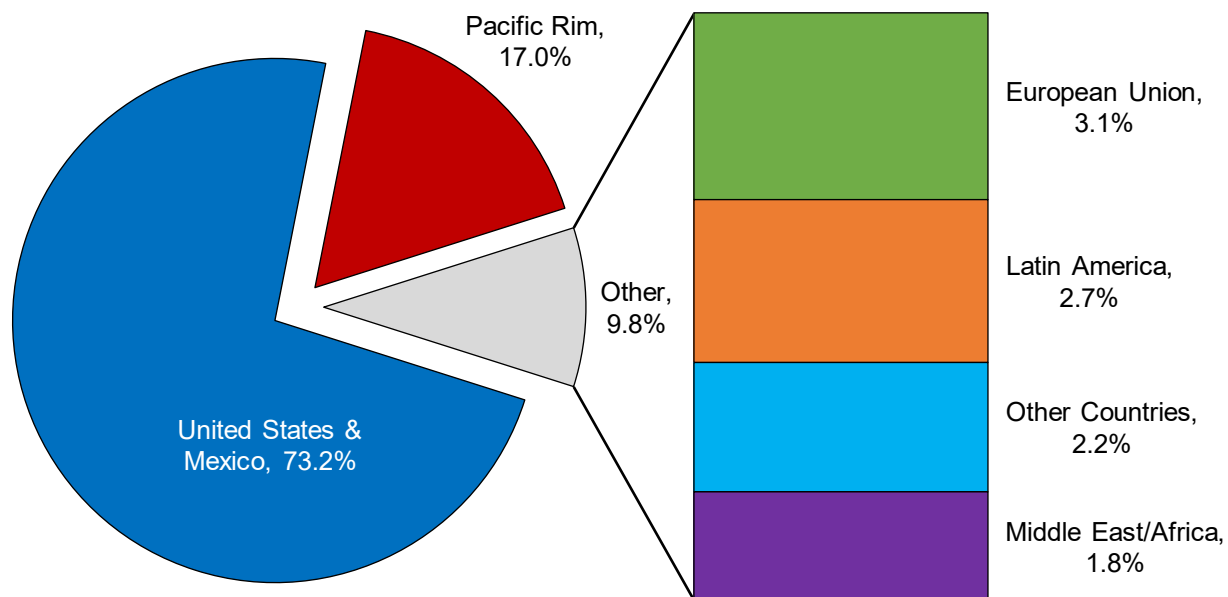

Manitoba domestic exports by country grouping, share (%)

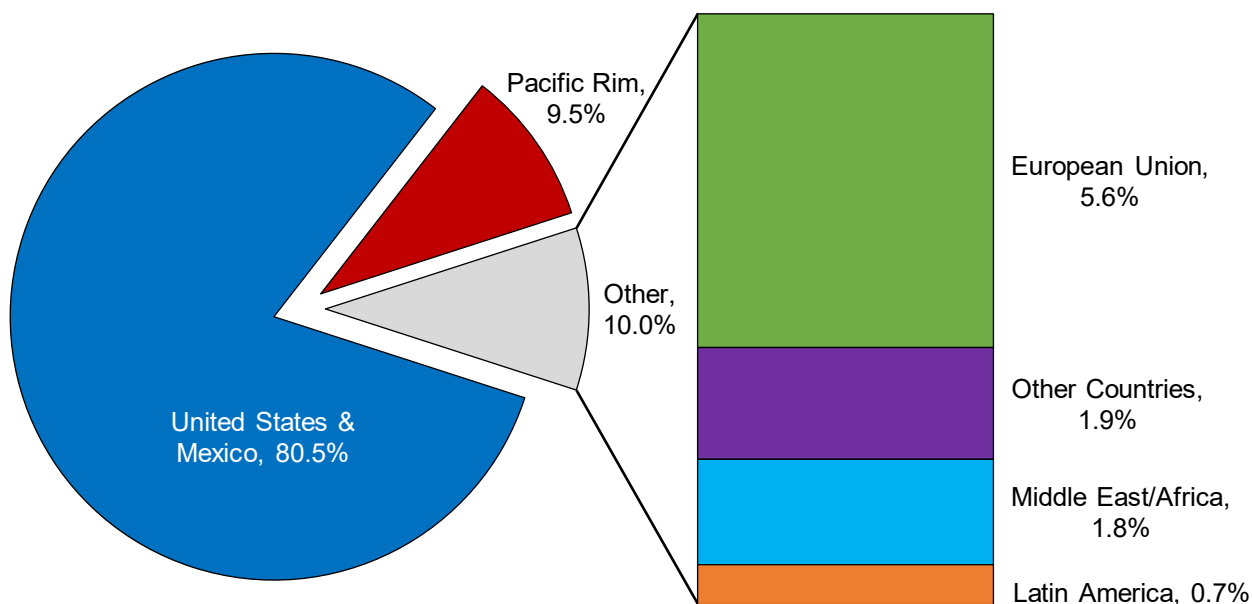
January to June 2025

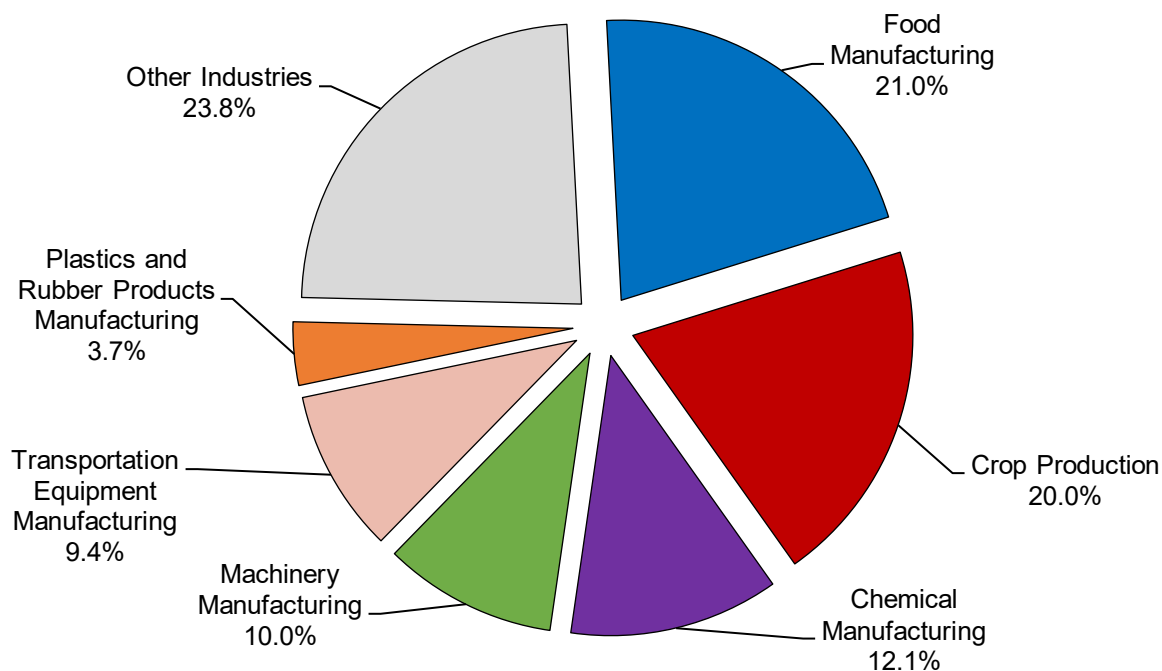

Manitoba domestic exports by industry, share (%)

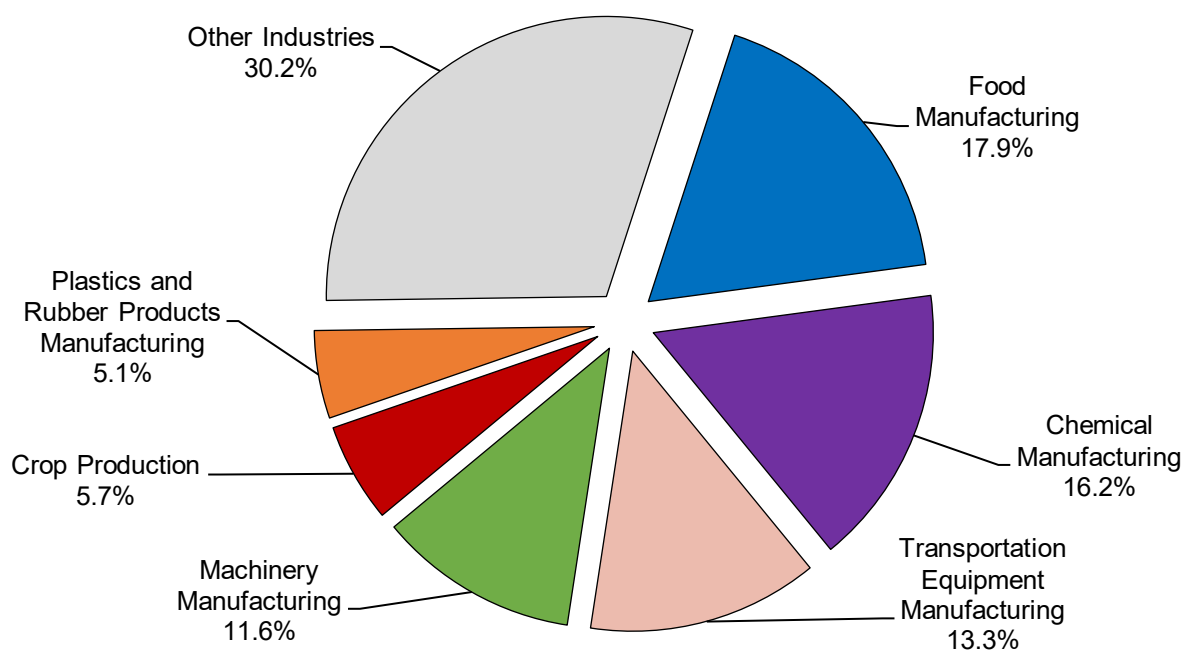
January to June 2025

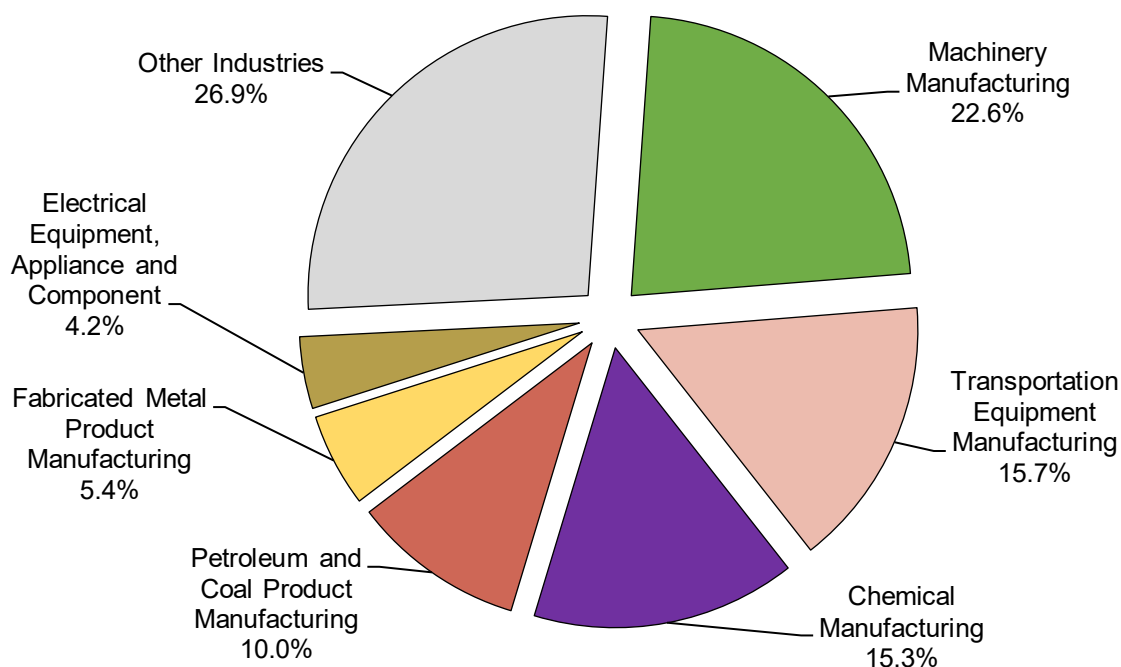

Manitoba imports by industry, share (%)

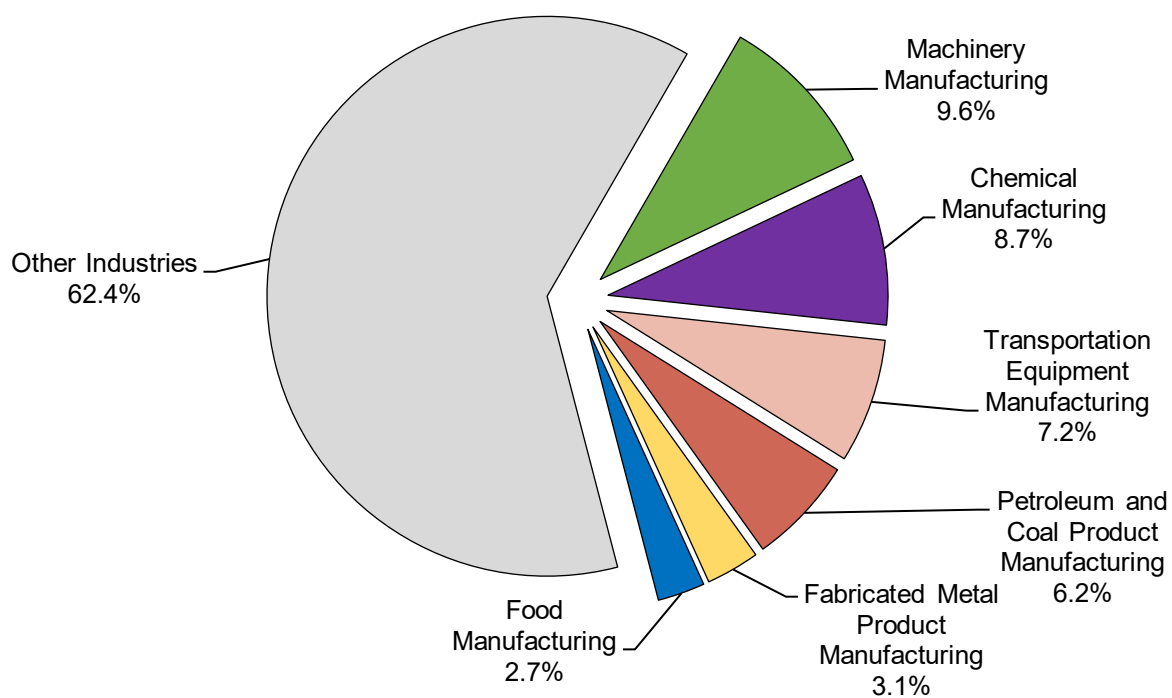
January to June 2025

Note to Readers

The Manitoba Bureau of Statistics (MBS) has prepared this report as part of its economic statistics program. The purpose is to provide Manitoba-level information on the importance and impact of international merchandise trade.

This publication provides merchandise export and import statistics by country, country grouping, commodity and industry. The information is from Statistics Canada's International Trade Division.

MBS adjusts the value of exports for some commodities in its Manitoba Economic Accounts. These adjustments are undertaken to better reflect the value of the foreign export of these commodities to the provincial economy.

Users should be aware that the export data is on a "province of origin" basis, while the import data is on a "province of clearance" basis. Therefore, imports from other countries are not counted if they are cleared through custom ports in other provinces and then shipped to Manitoba (MBS would count these as interprovincial imports). This implies that the trade balances calculated for individual countries could overstate Manitoba's actual position.

As part of the 2022 World Customs Organization (WCO) amendments, a number of HS codes were terminated and recoded. Updates at the 6-digit level are made every five years by the WCO to reflect evolving international standards and trade patterns. While all commodity data presented in this report are based on 4-digit Harmonized System (HS) codes, the information may still be affected by these changes.

All industry data presented in this report are based on the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) and derived from HS code values. The concordance file used to convert commodity data into industry values is sourced from Statistics Canada. With the introduction of HS 2022 codes, MBS has maintained revisions to this concordance file. As a result, there may be discrepancies in the industry-level details within this report when compared to other industry-based data sources.

The data presented in this report has been derived from the most current estimates released by Statistics Canada's International Trade Division. Revisions for the 2024 calendar year have been incorporated in this report.

In July 2025, MBS identified anomalies in Manitoba's pharmaceutical export data (HS 3004). An investigation by Statistics Canada found misreporting between May 2024 and May 2025, where some domestic exports were incorrectly classified as re-exports. Data for 2025 has been revised, and 2024 updates will follow in November. Users should interpret the affected data with caution until revisions are complete.
