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Manitoba Population Estimates: January 1, 2022 (Released March 17, 2022)

Statistics Canada has released its January 1, 2022 population estimates and fourth quarter 2021 demographic estimates for Canada, the provinces and territories.

According to Statistics Canada, Manitoba's total population was estimated at 1,390,249 residents as of January 1, 2022, up 3,916 individuals from the October 1, 2021 estimate. Population growth continues on a twelve-month basis, with Manitoba's increase since January 1, 2021 estimated at 8,790 people, or 0.64%. Although immigration levels have mostly rebounded from COVID-19 restrictions, an increased net interprovincial outflow hampers Manitoba's twelve-month growth.

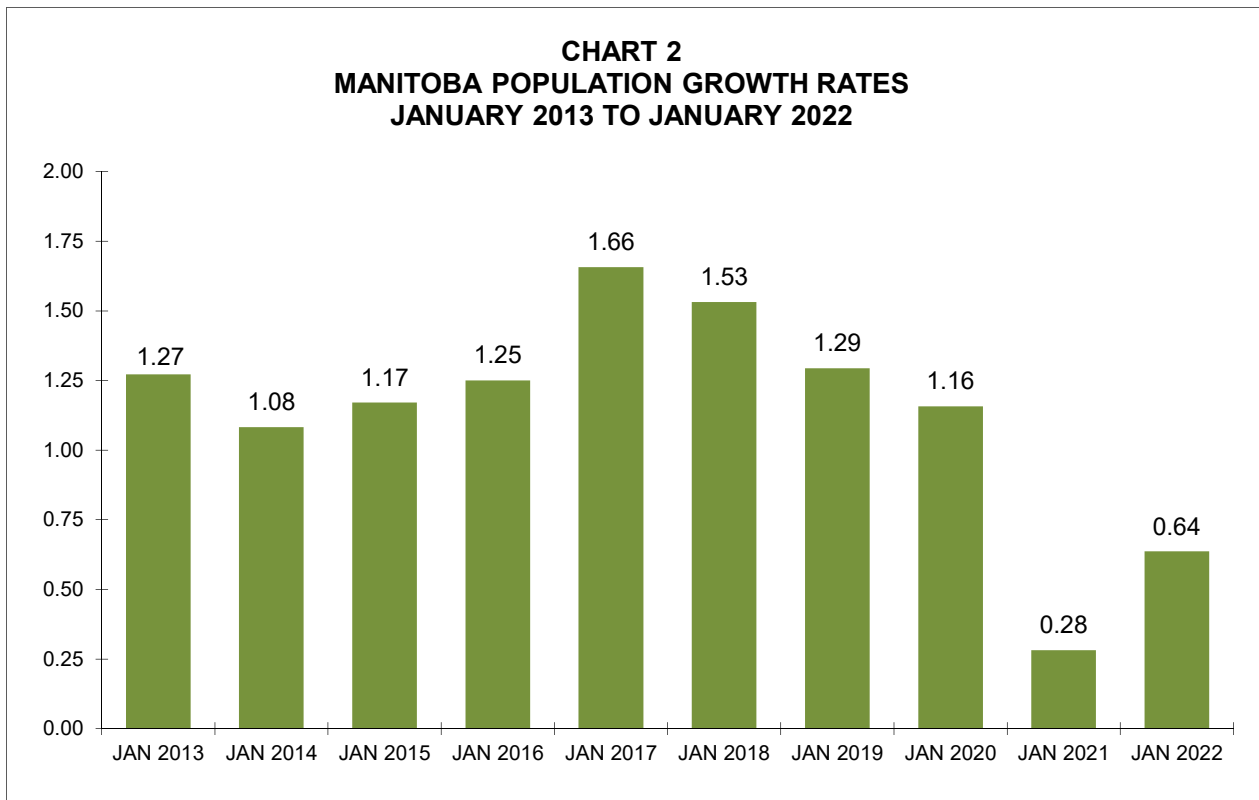
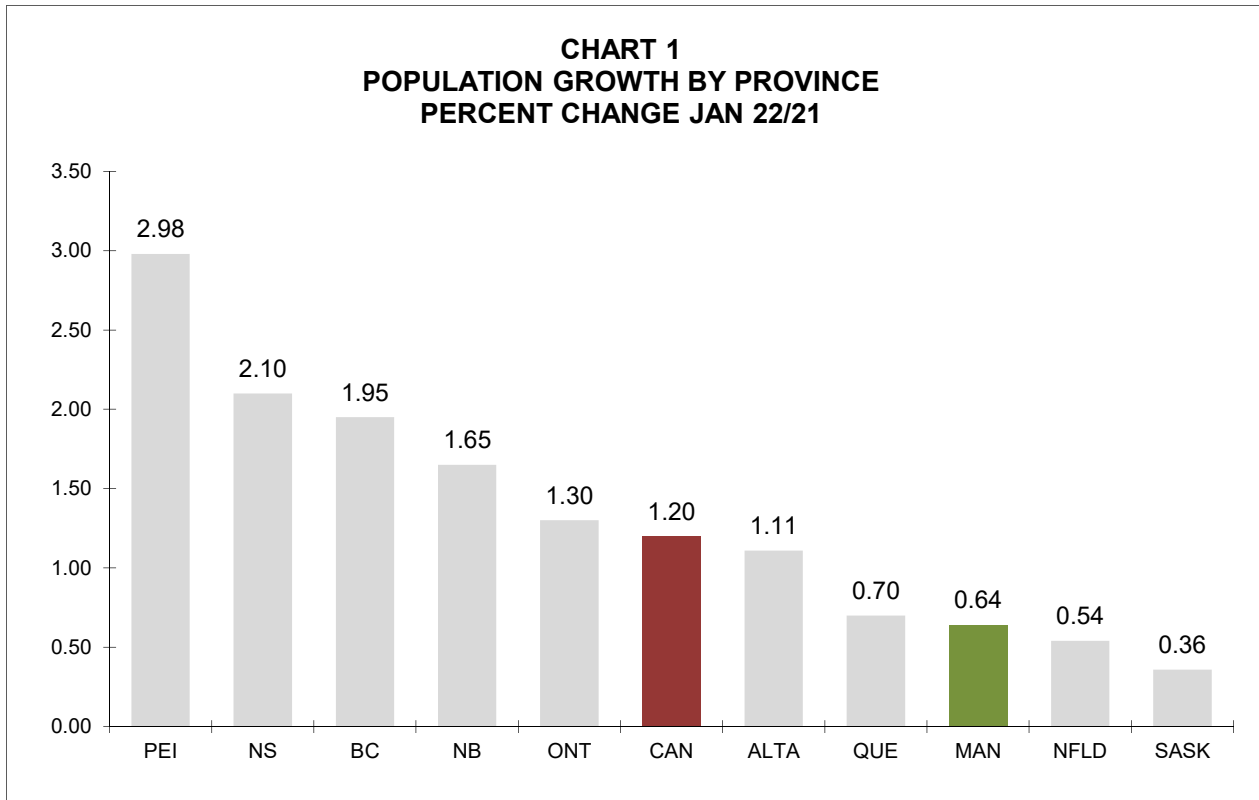
Net international migration for 2021 was 15,214 individuals, up from 8,176 people in 2020. Other international migration (that is, the net change in the number of Canadian citizens returning from abroad, non-permanent residents and Canadians temporarily abroad) was an estimated net gain of 2,568 migrants for 2021. This net gain is up from the net loss of 758 other international migrants estimated for 2020.

Through interprovincial migration, Manitoba recorded an estimated net loss to other provinces and territories of 12,529 residents during 2021. This net loss is larger than the net loss of 6,989 individuals in 2020. During 2021, Manitoba's largest net gains were from Prince Edward Island (38), Nunavut (34) and Yukon (18). The largest net losses were to British Columbia (-4,437), Alberta (-4,130) and Ontario (-2,489).

Generally, Manitoba's interprovincial migration losses are offset to some degree by other forms of migration. Combining the various forms of population movement, Manitoba recorded an overall net migration gain of 5,253 people in 2021. This net gain marked an increase of 4,824 individuals from the net gain of 429 migrants in 2020.

Note regarding COVID-19

On March 18, 2020 the Government of Canada implemented travel restrictions aimed at reducing the spread of COVID-19. In order to try and account for the restrictions imposed by Canada, and other countries, Statistics Canada adjusted their usual estimation methods for Emigrants, Returning Emigrants and Net Temporary Emigrants. Estimation methods for Deaths were adjusted to insure inclusion of COVID-19 deaths. Data supporting the estimation of most other components has not been affected, so no other COVID-19 related adjustments are being made at this time. However, due to a known data processing backlog in Manitoba at the end of 2020, estimation methods were adjusted for Manitoba's number of Births for the third quarter of 2021 onward.
