# **Business Counts**

## **June 2022**



## **Highlights**

- As of June 2022, Manitoba's business count with employees was 43,070, with 97.9% classifying as a small business (1-99 employees). Retail trade, construction, and health care had the highest counts of businesses with employees in Manitoba.
- Manitoba's business count without employees was **84,044** as of June 2022. Real estate, agriculture, and unclassified were the sectors with the highest counts of businesses without employees in Manitoba.

#### **Canadian business counts**

Canadian business counts provide counts of active businesses by industry classification and employment-size categories for Canada and the provinces and territories.

Each operating location is separately counted, including cases where one business comprises multiple locations. For example, a retail business with 10 stores represents 10 businesses in the Canadian business counts.

The data does not represent changes in the business population over time. Statistics Canada recommends that users not use the data as a time series.


#### **Business with employees**

In order to qualify as a *business with employees*, the business must meet **one** of the **three** following criteria:

- **1.** Have an employee workforce for which they submit payroll remittances to CRA
- **2.** Have a minimum of \$30,000 in annual revenue
- **3.** Are incorporated under a federal or provincial act and have filed a federal corporate income tax form within the past three years.

The three sectors in Manitoba with the highest number of businesses with employees were retail trade, health care, and construction. Retail trade made up **10.9%** of the total **43,070** businesses with employees in Manitoba. Construction was responsible for **10.8%**, and the health care sector made up another **10.7%**.

#### Number of businesses by employment size and industry

The percentage of **small** businesses (1-99 employees) was **97.9%** in Manitoba, and **98.1%** in Canada. **Medium** businesses (100-499 employees) accounted for **1.8%** of Manitoba's total, and **1.7%** nationally. **Large** businesses (500+ employees) made up **0.3%** of the total in Manitoba, and **0.2%** in Canada. *See appendix table 2 for a comprehensive list of business counts by employment size.* 

The industry in Manitoba with the highest count of **small businesses** was **construction** with **4,605** total. 2,478 of these construction businesses employed between 1 and 4 employees. **Health care and social assistance** had the highest count of businesses in the medium size range with **149**. **Educational services** had the highest count of large businesses with **30**. 


The counts of businesses without employees cover all enterprises which meet one of the following criteria:

- 1. is incorporated
- 2. shows a minimum of \$30,000 in revenue (non-taxable and/or taxable)

#### Number of Manitoba businesses without employees by sector



The three sectors in Manitoba that had the highest number of businesses without employees were real estate, agriculture, and unclassified sectors.

Real estate was responsible for

19.9% of the total 84,044 businesses without employees in Manitoba. Agriculture, which includes forestry, fishing, and hunting, made up 16.3% of the businesses in Manitoba. Unclassified sectors were the third largest category accounting for 11.3% of businesses without employees.

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) is an industry classification system encompassing all economic activities. It has a hierarchical structure. At the highest level, it divides the economy into 20 sectors. At lower levels, it further distinguishes the different economic activities in which businesses are engaged.

The unclassified sector is made up of economic activities that have yet to be assigned a NAICS code.
