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Manitoba Population Estimates: July 1, 2021 (Released September 29, 2021)

Statistics Canada has released its July 1, 2021 population estimates and July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 demographic estimates for Canada, the provinces and territories.

According to Statistics Canada, Manitoba's total population was estimated at 1,383,765 residents as of July 1, 2021, an increase of 3,117 individuals, or 0.23%, from the July 1, 2020 estimate of 1,380,648. COVID-19 restrictions resulted in just 10,194 newcomers over the last twelve months. This immigration reduction is at the core of Manitoba's lower growth.

Net international migration continues to be a major contributor to population growth, with Manitoba recording a net gain of 9,482 migrants during the twelve months ending June 30, 2021, down from 13,864 net migrants over the 2019/20 census year. Other international migration (that is, the net change in the number of Canadian citizens returning from abroad, non-permanent residents and Canadians temporarily abroad) was an estimated net gain of 432 migrants for 2020/21. This net gain is up from the net gain of 134 other international migrants estimated for 2019/20.

Through interprovincial migration, Manitoba recorded an estimated net loss to other provinces and territories of 9,685 residents during 2020/21. This net loss is larger than the net loss of 8,297 individuals in 2019/20. During 2020/21, Manitoba's largest net gains were from Nunavut (81), Newfoundland (45) and Prince Edward Island (29). The largest net losses were to British Columbia (-3,623), Alberta (-2,903) and Ontario (-2,297).

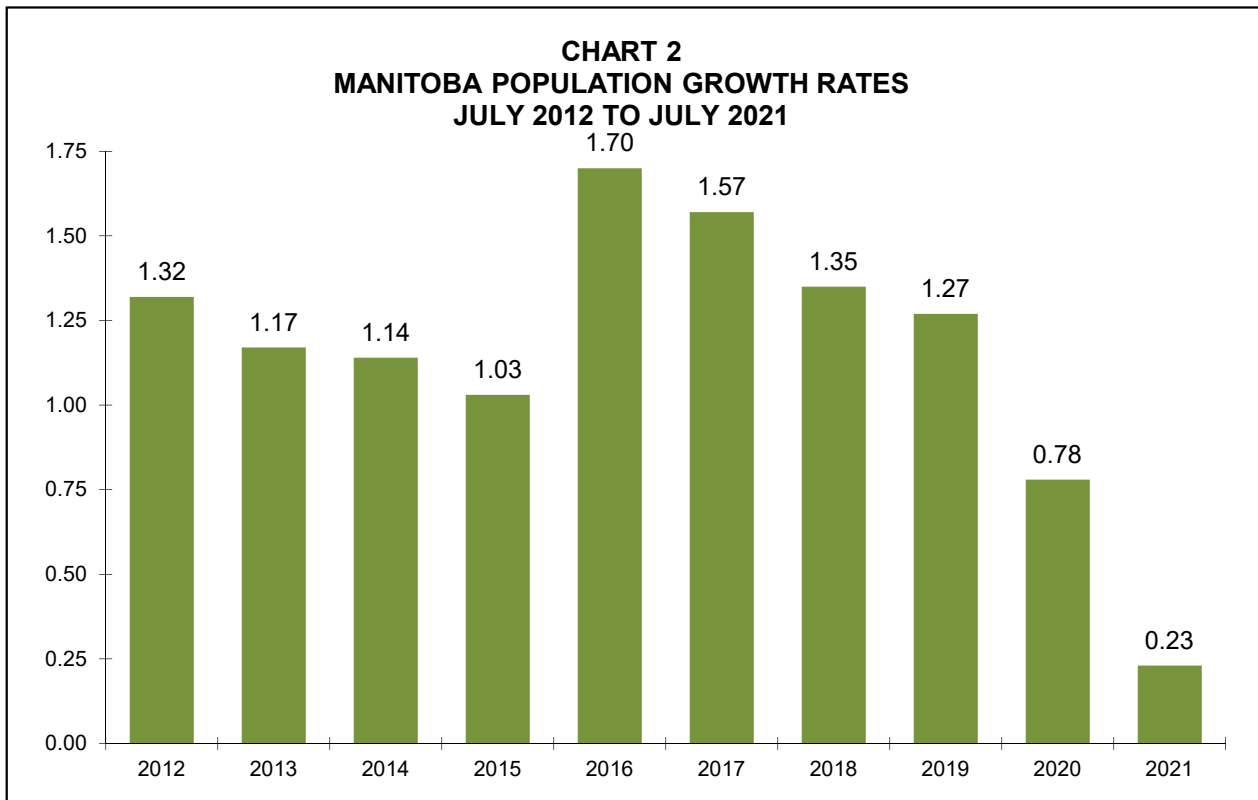
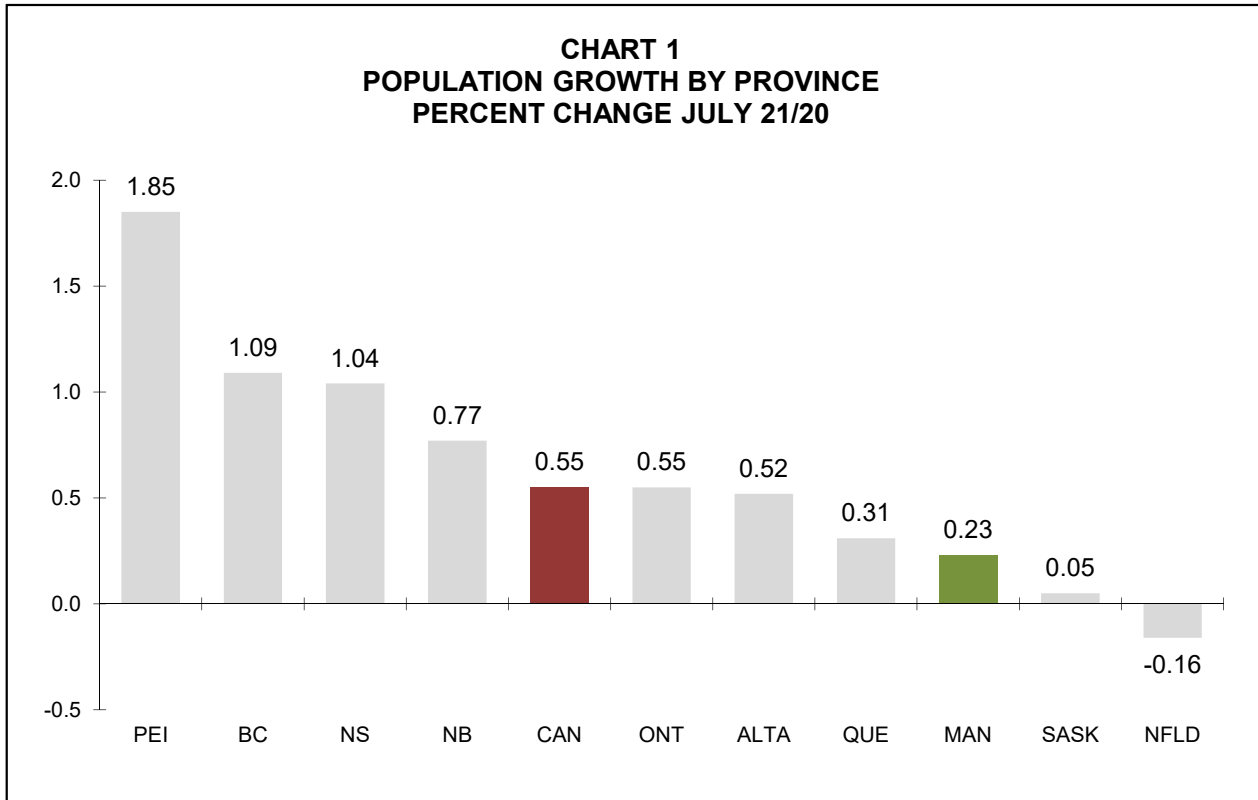
Generally, Manitoba's interprovincial migration losses are offset to some degree by other forms of migration. Combining the various forms of population movement, Manitoba recorded an overall net migration gain of 229 people in 2020/21. This net gain marked a decrease of 5,472 individuals from the net gain of 5,701 migrants in 2019/20.

Statistics Canada has released revised demographic estimates for the third quarter 2016 onward. This MBS report incorporates all revisions.

Tables 5, 6 and 7 present the differences between the current estimates and those previously published by Statistics Canada for Tables 1, 2 and 4.

Note regarding COVID-19

On March 18, 2020 the Government of Canada implemented travel restrictions aimed at reducing the spread of COVID-19. In order to try and account for the restrictions imposed by Canada, and other countries, Statistics Canada adjusted their usual estimation methods for Emigrants, Returning Emigrants and Net Temporary Emigrants. Estimation methods for Deaths were adjusted to insure inclusion of COVID-19 deaths. Data supporting the estimation of other components has not been affected, so no other COVID-19 related adjustments are being made at this time.
