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Manitoba Population Estimates: July 1, 2022 (Released September 28, 2022)

Statistics Canada has released its July 1, 2022 population estimates and July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 demographic estimates for Canada, the provinces and territories.

According to Statistics Canada, Manitoba's total population was estimated at 1,409,223 residents as of July 1, 2022, an increase of 17,244 individuals, or 1.24%, from the July 1, 2021 estimate of 1,391,979. Although Manitoba's twelve-month immigration levels are the highest on record, net interprovincial outflows not seen since 1989/90 hamper growth.

Net international migration continues to be a major contributor to population growth, with Manitoba recording a net gain of 20,084 migrants during the twelve months ending June 30, 2022, up from 9,309 net migrants over the 2020/21 census year. Other international migration (that is, the net change in the number of Canadian citizens returning from abroad, non-permanent residents and Canadians temporarily abroad) was an estimated net gain of 4,582 migrants for 2021/22. This net gain is up from the net gain of 1,460 other international migrants estimated for 2020/21.

Through interprovincial migration, Manitoba recorded an estimated net loss to other provinces and territories of 10,203 residents during 2021/22. This net loss is larger than the net loss of 2,804 individuals in 2020/21. During 2021/22, Manitoba's largest net gains were from Northwest Territories (73) and Yukon (12). The largest net losses were to Alberta (-4,660), British Columbia (-3,349) and Ontario (-1,149).

Generally, Manitoba's interprovincial migration losses are offset to some degree by other forms of migration. Combining the various forms of population movement, Manitoba recorded an overall net migration gain of 14,463 people in 2021/22. This net gain marked an increase of 6,498 individuals from the net gain of 7,965 migrants in 2020/21.

Statistics Canada has released revised demographic estimates for the third quarter 2019 onward. This MBS report incorporates all revisions.

Tables 5, 6 and 7 present the differences between the current estimates and those previously published by Statistics Canada for Tables 1, 2 and 4.

Notes to Users

Regarding COVID-19

On March 18, 2020 the Government of Canada implemented travel restrictions aimed at reducing the spread of COVID-19. In order to try and account for the restrictions imposed by Canada, and other countries, Statistics Canada adjusted their usual estimation methods for Emigrants, Returning Emigrants and Net Temporary Emigrants. Beginning in 2022, as COVID-19 related travel restrictions started to lift, Statistics Canada modified their methodology adjustments to reflect a return towards pre-pandemic migration levels.

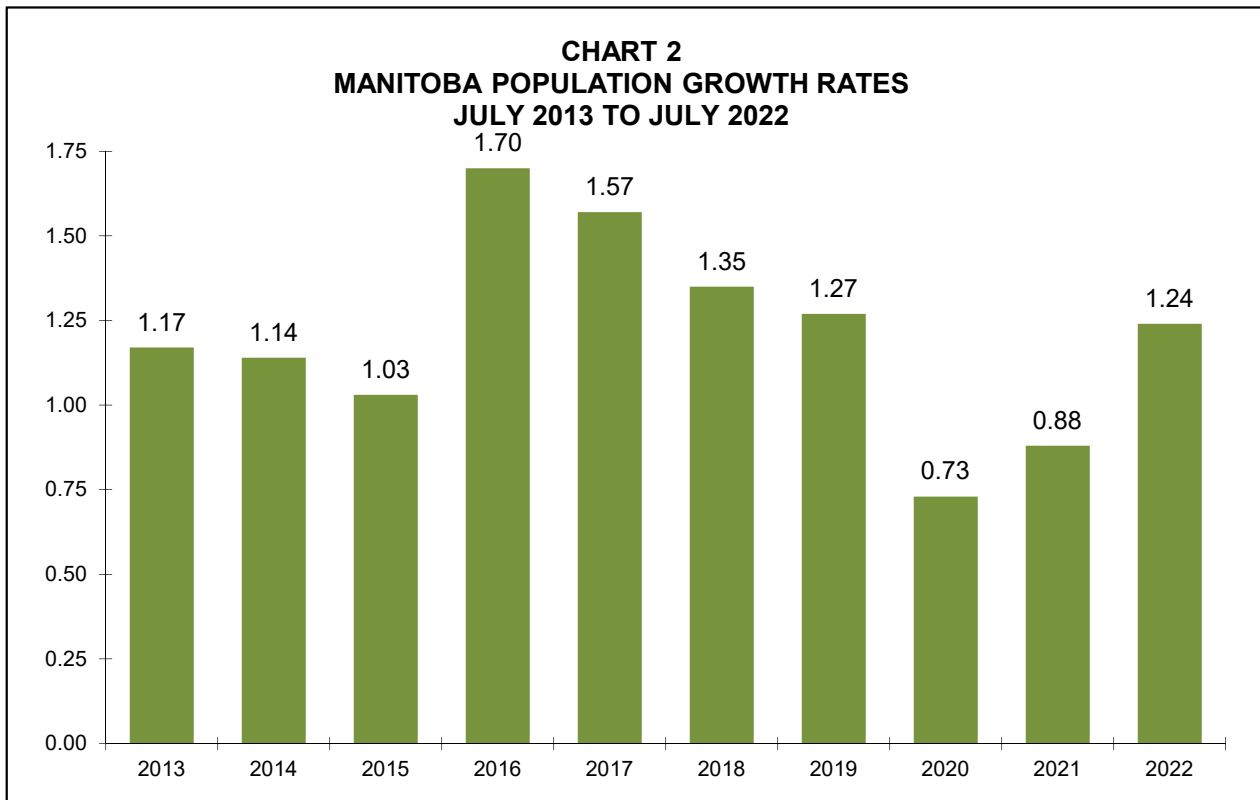
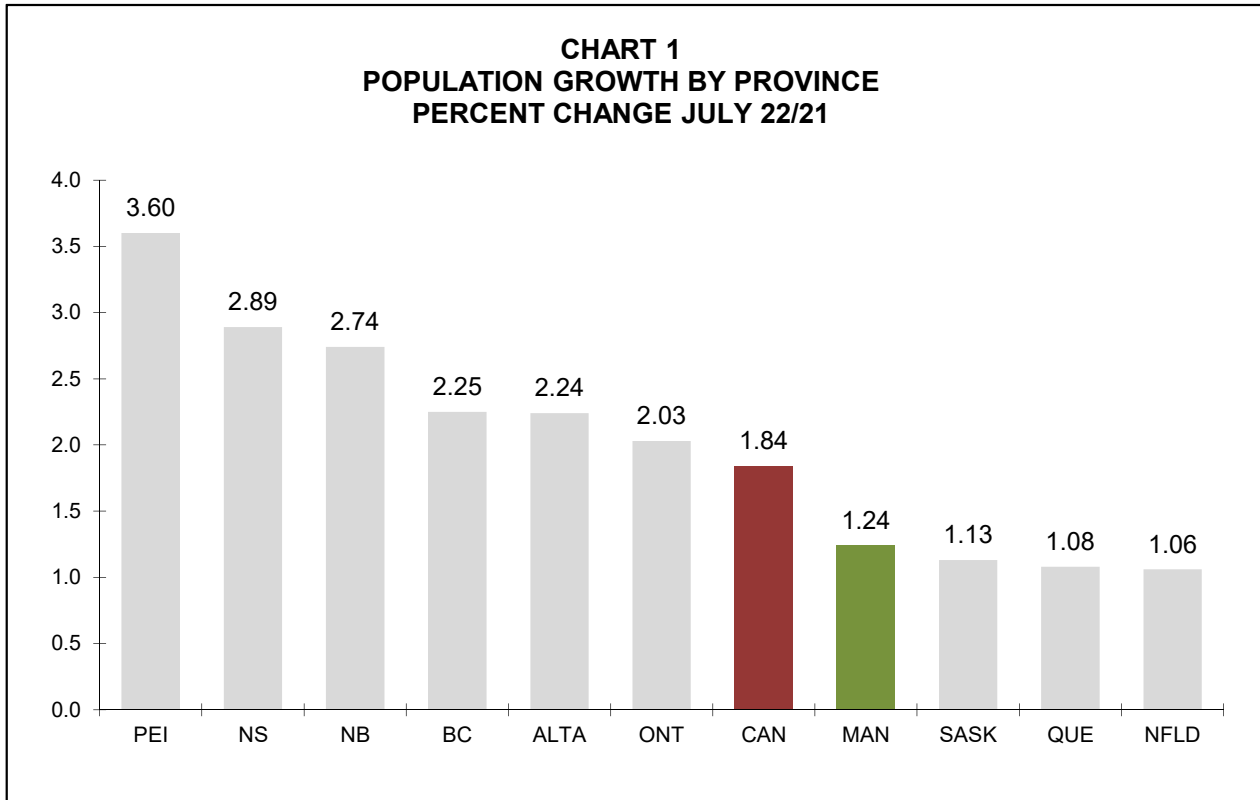
For first quarter 2022, Statistics Canada has returned to their usual estimation methods for Emigrants, Returning Emigrants and Net Temporary Emigrants. Estimation methods for Deaths continue to be adjusted to insure inclusion of COVID-19 deaths. Data supporting the estimation of other components has not been affected, so no other COVID-19 related adjustments are being made at this time.

Birth Registration Delays

Estimation methods for 2022 Births have been adjusted for Nova Scotia and Manitoba due to data availability issues.

Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET)

Since March 17, 2022, persons with a Canada-Ukraine authorization for emergency travel who are on Canadian soil are included in the Net Non-permanent Resident estimates.
