

Employment among Males increased by 1.4% (+5,200) when compared to January 2023.

FULL-TIME VS PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT

+12,100 vs -7,300

Full-time employment increased by 12,100 positions (+2.2%) from January to February, while part-time employment decreased by 7,300 positions (-5.9%).



AVERAGE HOURLY WAGE GROWTH

+5.5%

Manitoba average hourly wages rose 5.5% (+\$1.53 to \$29.29) on a year over year basis, higher than Canada's 5.4% growth (+\$1.69 to \$33.16).
