An increase of 1,200 jobs (+0.2%) from September to October 2023. Canada increased by 0.1%.

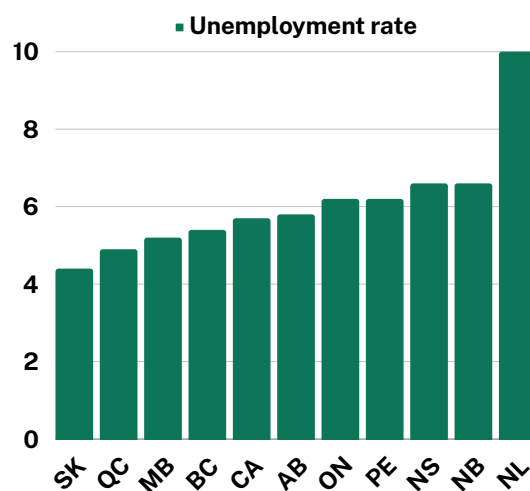
Manitobans in the Labour Force

An increase of 2,400 Manitobans (+0.3%) from September to October 2023. Canadians in the labour force increased by 0.3%.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE:

5.2%

Manitoba's unemployment rate of 5.2% ranks third among provinces, and also lower than Canada's 5.7%.



PRIVATE-SECTOR EMPLOYMENT:

+2,300

Private sector employment gained 2,300 jobs (+0.4%) from September to October 2023.

PUBLIC-SECTOR EMPLOYMENT:

-1,100

Public sector employment lost 1,100 jobs (-0.6%) from September to October 2023.

FULL-TIME VS PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT

-900 vs +2,200

Full-time employment decreased by 900 positions (-0.2%) from September to October, while part-time employment increased by 2,200 positions (+1.8%).



AVERAGE HOURLY WAGE GROWTH

+3.9%

Manitoba average hourly wages rose 3.9% (+\$1.12 to \$30.14) on a year-over-year basis, lower than Canada's 4.8% growth (+\$1.56 to \$34.08).
