An increase of 3,900 jobs (0.5%) from August to September 2025. Canada's total jobs increased by 0.3%.

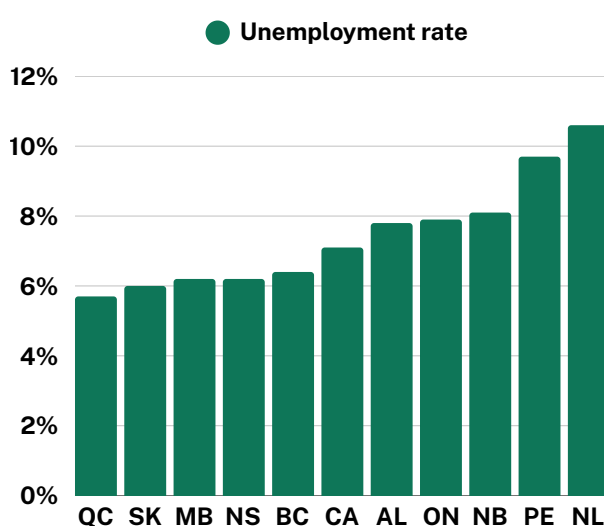
Manitobans in the Labour Force

An increase of 7,900 Manitobans (1.0%) from August to September 2025. Canadians in the labour force increased by 0.3%.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE:

6.2%

Manitoba's unemployment rate of 6.2% tied for third lowest among provinces, and also below Canada's average of 7.1%.



PRIVATE-SECTOR EMPLOYMENT:

+1,100

Private sector employment gained 1,100 jobs (0.2%) from August to September 2025.

PUBLIC-SECTOR EMPLOYMENT:

+2,800

Public sector employment gained 2,800 jobs (1.5%) from August to September 2025.

FULL-TIME VS PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT

+11,100 vs -7,200

Full-time employment increased by 11,100 positions (1.8%) from August 2025 to September 2025, while part-time employment decreased by 7,200 positions (-5.4%).



AVERAGE HOURLY WAGE GROWTH

+4.1%

Manitoba average hourly wages rose 4.1% (+\$1.25 to \$31.58) on a year-over-year basis, higher than Canada's 3.3% growth (+\$1.17 to \$36.78).
