## UNDER THE PLANNING ACT VARIATION ORDER BY CARMAN-DUFFERIN PLANNING DISTRICT VARIATION BOARD

VARIATION ORDER NO: 2020/004D

WHEREAS Rosevalley Colony (Marvin Waldner) has applied for Rosevalley Holdings Co Ltd, owner(s) of property legally described as 22-06-06 W and located at 33091 Road 33W in the RM of Dufferin, to the Carman-Dufferin Planning District Variation Board to vary the application of Carman-Dufferin Planning District Development Plan By-law #03/2014, provided under Part 6 of The Planning Act as it applies to the property in order to vary the established requirements in accordance with the appended Carman-Dufferin Planning District Zoning By-law #04/2014, as follows:

To vary the distance between the earthen manure storage and a residence from the required 4594 ft to 3650 ft

To vary the separation distance from a designated area (Graysville) from the required 9186 ft to 7920 ft

To allow for the expansion of the hog and bird operation.

And after careful consideration of the application and any representations made for or against the variation sought by the applicant,

The Carman-Dufferin Planning District Variation Board in meeting duly assembled this **20th day of May 2020** passed the following resolution to **APPROVE** the said Variation:

Moved by John Peckover, seconded by Brent Owen; Be it resolved that the Carman-Dufferin Planning District approve the variation order request of Rosevalley Holdings Co Ltd to vary the distance between the earthen manure storage and a residence from the required 4594 ft to 3650 ft and to vary the separation distance from a designated area (Graysville) from the required 9186 ft to 7920 ft in a "AR" (Agricultural Restricted) zone at 33091 Road 33W; Section 22-06-06 W in the RM of Dufferin. Carried.
