This letter is in reference to the proposed Establishment of Pig Operation Hylife Marker's Mark (TRC 12-090) located in the RM of Deloraine Winchester location SE ¼ 17-02-23 WPM

I was born and raised in Deloraine MB I have been fortunate to be able to live and raise a family and run a business in Deloraine for over 30 years. I own a property one mile from the proposed site which I have obtained from a generous man who made sure I could own a beautiful piece of property. To most people it's just a piece of pasture but to me it is much more than that. It has taken me all my life savings to obtain this property as a dream of my future. My children are excited to maintain this property in the future. My daughter was married on this property so it has a VERY special place in our hearts. My friends and family come to hunt, enjoy evening bonfires and long walks through our trails we have made in the quarter section which through COVID times has been a major mental relief.

If the proposed Hog Operation goes ahead my future use and plans for my property will be greatly impacted in a negative way to the point I will have to sell.

So my greatest concern is the SMELL from the hog barn. I will not be able to tolerate this side effects of the production of these barns. This completely discredits my love of the land I own and have worked so hard to obtain as a special place for my family.

I attended the presentation Hylife put on at the Deloraine Community Hall, I was informed at that time by an employee of Hylife that the presentation was done to see if the community wanted a barn in the area as part of our community.

The well prepared presentation made me realize that the project has been in the works for some time and for the most part has been kept quite from the general public.

These large corporations know how to be prepared for the public and government guidelines.

They informed me of the water quantity and quality found at the barn, but my question/concern is can that supply be used for the Town of Deloraine in the event that the town's current overland supply is deemed unusable and still support the barns?

I am skeptical that the public's voice will not be heard due to provincial guidelines and over ruling of our local council government body. Your invitation to express concerns via mail pamphlet with a map of the area of the proposed site was misleading by not including the watersheds and creeks that surround the proposed site.

After attending the presentation of the Hog Barn Proposal and trying to leave my direct personal feelings out of the situation, I believe that the Hog production barn will impact my community in a negative way as I do not feel the positive spin offs of this proposal outweigh the negative ones.

If my local community feels strongly for this proposal then I have to commit to their decision, however I feel the majority of our community has already voiced their decline to this proposal presented.

I ask that you as a Technical Review Co-ordination Unit to respect and allow our community and council to have the final say in this proposal

We are NOT in favour of the pig barn operation being built south of Deloraine for the following reasons:

1. we have air ambulance landing at the airport different times and the smell from the barns would not be a pleasant odor for the medical personal or the patient to have to endure...
2. we like to have our windows open lots and that would be impossible with the smell from the barns
3. we like to sit outside in the evenings to enjoy the weather and that would be impossible with the smell
4. the roads in that area that the semis would be traveling on are not made for that sort of traffic.....they would need about 18 to 20 inches of clay cap ..packed down and then good gravel on top.... this would cost ALOT of money and who is going to foot the bill for that??
5. the crap that is injected into the ground is eventually going to seep down the mountain into the water source and that is not a good thing...

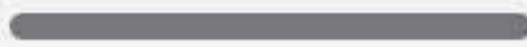

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I am writing to express my concern regarding the establishment of hog barns south of Deloraine, Manitoba. My husband and I live in Deloraine and are both considerably opposed to this venture. I realize it is five miles from Deloraine but the odor will travel this far if the wind is in the SE direction. This will be a detriment to our community and will devalue property in town. We have often been in Killarney, Manitoba when the wind is in the wrong direction. The smell is thoroughly disgusting. We also had pigs on our farm when we were farming so we know the terrible odor involved.

The odor is bad enough but this is not a farming enterprise like a family farm. It is an industrial enterprise and the wear and tear on the roads needed to transport the hogs is going to contribute to more upkeep and repair of the current roads which will eventually impact our taxes. It is not going to help our economy in anyway unless Hylife is going to contribute substantially to the community of Deloraine apart from the taxes they will pay. After the enterprise is set up, there will be minimal employment available, not enough to be of any economic benefit to this community.

I trust the government will consider the opinion of those that will be impacted by this venture.

In response to the proposed HyLife Maker's Mark hog operation near Deloraine, I would like to express my opposition to this location.

My husband and I attended their presentation held in Deloraine, and were not appeased by the answers we were told about our concerns.

The planned location will be on a flat spot on the side of the Turtle Mountain. However, there is a lot of land above the site. If there is a heavy rain, or fast spring melt from heavy snowfall, will the dike around the lagoon hold from the runoff off the mountain? Environmental damage downside of the hog operation will occur if the excess water breaches the dike. Contaminated water from this area will end up in Deloraine.

Measured in a straight line, our farm is about 3 miles from the proposed location. Our son's family home is closer. The entire community of Goodlands is about the same distance. Hog operations stink. From driving past the barns in Killarney and Souris, we know the smell is not eliminated by trees around the edge. When wind is from the north east, or when the humidity is high and air is heavy, we will smell this stench at our home. This will severely diminish our enjoyment of living our retirement years on our farm. The farmers operating our farmland will have to work in this stench. And the residents of Goodlands certainly do not want to live and work in this smell. Trees around the edge of the barn can not grow fast enough to deflect the odour to make any substantial difference for years. After all, we were here first.

All of my life, I have and continue to farm north of Deloraine in the Municipality of Deloraine Winchester. We need hog barns within the Deloraine Winchester area because of the numerous benefits to the community and the Municipality. The community seems to believe that all we hear about is the "SMELL." The wind does not stay in the same direction twenty four hours a day, seven days a week. With new technology, the odour from hog manure continues to improve. Odours are not constant and occur at specific times of the year.

I want to register my very strong support for the proposed HyLife development within our Municipality and the expansion of the hog industry in rural Manitoba. A project of this size has incredible benefits for our area and we can see those benefits in the Municipalities to the east, west and north of us. Our Municipality is surrounded by the benefits of the economic impacts of the hog industry. The job creation, cultural benefits, groceries purchased, gasoline required, construction required, medical, school, churches, etc. – all of these will see an increase in participation with those that will contribute to and maintain this project.

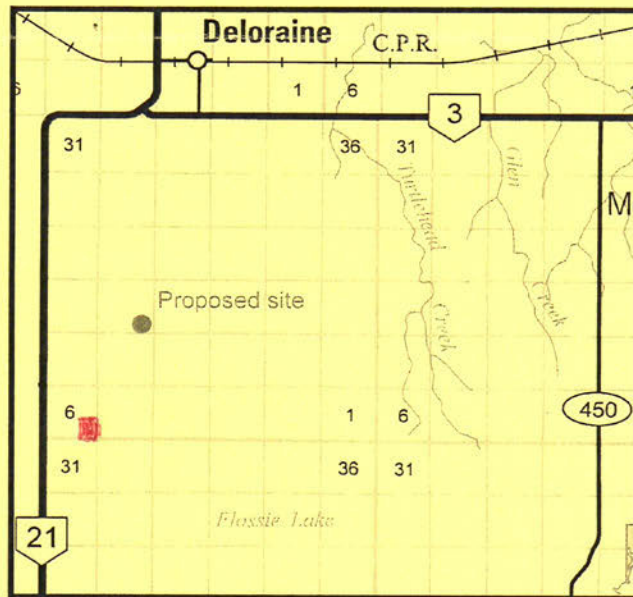

As president of the Deloraine Flying Club, I am writing this submission on behalf of the membership. Due to Covid restrictions, I conducted a straw pole of the membership to garner opinions on the proposed hog barn, adjacent to the Deloraine Airport.

There was a strong majority of our membership that were very much opposed to this proposal. I also consulted with others, who have had first hand experience with facilities of this nature. At this proximity, we can expect to experience an unpleasant odor, even on calm days. On days with southerly winds, the smell will be unbearable. One can only imagine what it will be like on the days when they spread manure.

As you know, the club's only fundraiser is an outdoor Fly-In Breakfast. How will we be able to plan that event, not knowing in advance what the wind direction will be? When people from out of town fly into our airport, and are greeted with that odor, they will be left with an unpleasant and lasting impression. Those with personal experience claim that even the town of Deloraine will be negatively affected on days with southerly winds.

It is our hope that the Deloraine Winchester Council will turn down Hylife's expansion plan for our municipality.

OPPOSED to this development for the following reasons:

- Location is too close to the town of Deloraine, the Deloraine Golf Club, the Deloraine Reservoir and Airport and will negatively affect the air quality of all especially when the waste is injected in the adjacent lands.
- Predominant southwest winds in the area will definitely impact the recreation facilities named above. The Golf Club has been attracting green fee players from many outside communities in order to remain operational but who is going to return to a course experiencing the odors produced by a hog operation. Fisherman use the Reservoir adjacent to the dam and will also be negatively affected. A shelter belt does not contain odors.
- The Deloraine Cemetery is located south of the proposed site. Many are choosing graveside services – we can only hope there is no wind that day.
- New homes have recently been built in the area and will be impacted especially when the application of injected waste occurs. There is potential for real estate values to be affected in the town as well. The land seller will not be affected by either and could have opted to do the development nearer their own residence.
- Concerns about the water supply – have had both drought and overland flooding in the past. This operation requires significant amounts of water.
- The impact on gravel roads to the site will be significant due to the feed and transport trucks required to support the operation.

I am writing to you on behalf of my family regarding the proposed hog barn by HyLife TRC 12-090 to be built on SE ¼ 17-2-23 in the municipality of Deloraine-Winchester. We have many concerns with a hog barn this size being built in such close proximity to several residences which are generational farms. Speaking for ourselves directly who own 2 properties (one within half a mile of the proposed site) we have moved here recently to help out with the 5 generation farm and invested heavily into our hobby farm into an area and community that clearly shows a declining population.

We live on the NW ¼ of 3-2-23 WPM, about 2.5 km from the suggested build site. There are 3 houses within this distance that are all family members of mine.

One of our main concerns is the strong odours that would be emitted. At any given wind direction, there will be several residences and facilities negatively impacted. We feel there has been little consideration into the actual devastation that will impact the golf course, the dam, the town and the cottage area; not to mention the recreational use with many hunting cabins, wildlife and a Snoman snowmobile trail that will all be negatively impacted.

We run a competitive show jumping and training facility of sport horses which incorporates an outdoor riding facility which will be directly affected. The decision to build this hog barn AND process its waste in the form of fertilizer again within a mile from our home also negatively impacts the resale of our beautiful acreage. We are proud owners of conservation land so we worry that the stench, run off and excessive amount of water needed to run a facility of this size may have long lasting effects on more than the humans that inhabit the area. Our conservation study clearly indicates we are proudly home to many endangered or threatened species.

The reality is, odour caused from decomposing manure, rotting feed, and dead pigs, are all a reality of a large-scale hog barn. I must ask the question – is this worth it for the 4 jobs it creates??? How can you reassure us that the aquifer they are pulling water from will remain viable and uncontaminated?

We are also concerned that with the increase of heavy truck traffic, as our roads will continue to deteriorate. This is a municipality that struggles to maintain roads adequately no matter what the season. Examples: the culvert for my road 7N took over a year to be replaced after being washed out. Flossie road saw a major culvert wash out - again it took months to fix with residents having to drive miles out of their way to get to town. These roads are never plowed in a timely manner so I wonder how a feed truck/ Rothsay/ pig hauler will manage and stay on its daily schedule – let alone the maintenance the roads will require. So the additional daily traffic on an otherwise quiet gravel road will affect the roads condition.

There is very little to benefit from this operation – the site landowners/investors conveniently live 20 minutes away from the site and already operate an extremely viable business; BUT the municipality gets a very small contribution of tax money, the town, the neighbors, the airport the golf course & dam all will suffer. Why not build it beside their home and in their own town ?

Not to mention the pigs themselves – can one person seriously look after 2,500 pigs each day? A hog operation can attempt to control these odours, but a certain degree of them are unavoidable. This would undoubtedly lead to decreased quality of life permanently, as well as decreased property values in the area.

Once this barn is built it will remain there, not only for our lifetime, but future generations as well. Please take our concerns seriously as this decision has the power to impact our quality of life and our children permanently. We recently submitted a petition to your office with the names of nearly every resident within a five-mile radius of this proposed hog barn.

LETTER OF OBJECTION

The proposed establishment of a pig operation 'HyLife Maker's Mark (TRC12-090)

We are writing to voice our concerns and objections on the main issues of this proposed project.

Process

The DeloraineWinchester council which is our local representative has already voted against the project. However, the provincial government may rule and ok a project that has already been locally declined. This undermines the confidence we have in the voice that our council represents in the democratic process.

The following are the issues that we have serious objections and concerns about.

Roads

Municipal roads will suffer with increased use of semi tractor trailers. Two semis a day may seem like a small number, but municipal roads are not the most robust, with deterioration happening over the longer term.

Hwy 21 will have spring road weight restrictions, this will necessitate alternate routes, and increase the travel onto the surrounding municipal roads and have a detrimental effect on those roads. This concern is not mentioned or addressed in the assessment.

Who will be responsible for the road maintenance when the inevitable road deterioration happens, this should not be the sole responsibility of the municipality? Or, will the road restrictions be changed, this then causing a problem for Hwy 21?

Environmental Concern

Water

The amount of water needed for the barns is a proposed well, that has no guarantee that it will be able to supply the amount required, 20,485 imperial gallons/day. The maximum annual water is listed as 31 imperial gallons, this makes no sense, it questions the reliability of the numbers stated. In reviewing the calculator it should have been cubic decametres. What other statements and numbers are incorrect in this document?

There is nothing in the assessment of where supplemental water would come from if the well is unable to continuously or temporarily unable to supply the required amount. Will the town municipal reservoir be tapped? The reservoir itself has no continuous water source, only spring run off. Would there be a guarantee that this will not occur? Would the project then not be approved?

Would this high usage of water have an impact on the surrounding well water users?



Manure Storage

Earthen manure storage facility, that is uncovered, is it seepage proof? Would this facility be lined, and if so with what? Is there a calculation for what is considered to be allowable seepage?

This storage facility is planned to be near a ravine, What measures would be in place if an overflow should occur or there is a break in the container lined or not? The envisioned downward run into the ravine, could continue to flow to the nearest community and then onward? Has what would be possible impact on the flora and fauna along the ravine even been considered?

Air Quality

The air quality will be impacted by the malodorous uncovered storage facility. The plans for a shelter belt to be planted are not sufficient. It is air porous, plus trees taking ten to fifteen years to grow is not an immediate solution to an immediate problem.

This deterioration in air quality would have an impact on the nearby residents, community; especially the mental health when the winds are blowing their way, and wildlife.

There is the consideration of possible economical benefit to the Deloraine Municipal area, however, this is greatly countered by: the impact of deteriorated roads, impact on local available water sources, air pollution, wild life impact, decreased property values, which by far outweigh the financial benefit and lastly the opinion of the local people being ignored. I am writing concerning the proposed establishment of a pig operation
Hylife Maker's Mark (TRC 12-090)

In my opinion there couldn't be a worse location for a pig operation.

- 1) Location is too close to main population of the municipality.
Town of Deloraine is 4 miles north of building site. It is 2 miles north of the closest quarter Sec NE20-02-23W, 2.5 miles north of quarters SE28-02-23W, SW21-02-23W, SE21-02-23W – proposed Spread Fields.
- 2) Environmental Concerns- barn on side of Turtle Mountain Ravine north of barn does go west. People here have pastures and dugouts on edge of the ravine have concerns big rains could move spread field injection fields down to there and contaminate their dugouts and wells. Heavy rain could erode injection fields east and south of barn sites and carry this toward town or across our airstrip. In the past the airstrip has had field debris washed on the runway that needed to be removed by MB good roads equipment it was so heavy. We have had rain so heavy on the mountain that it heavily flooded the town.
- 3) All drainage from the mountain ends up in Souris River. Ravine north of proposed barn site goes west approximately 20-25 miles and ends up in Souris River. The water coming around town of Deloraine goes to Medora creek and ends up in Souris River north of Medora. How many towns are down river from where these two supplies enter the Souris River.



- 4) Air Pollution – The airstrip which is the only paved runway in southwest Manitoba runs right up to the farthest north proposed injection field and is only 0.5 miles north of next 3 quarter sections. People here have hangers with planes in them. The Air Ambulance can land on this airstrip. Is it going to come and land if it lands once shortly after fields are injected? We have 3 new houses built just south of injection fields and one forever home. We have people with new homes in town. We have a cemetery just 2 miles north of the injection field. What a nice memorial service we would have there just after injection. A big question I have and I think I've answered is why nobody that wants a pig barn wants it built near their residence. Our golf course and our dam are too close to these injection fields. The Turtle Mountain is a weather maker and creates heavy rains and winds which in summer are mainly south and southwest or west just pointed right at our population and recreation areas.
- 5) There is a cattle operation on the mountain but I'm sure pasture land doesn't erode as much as land newly injected with 3 million gallons of liquid waste. I wonder who is going to be responsible for cleanup of contaminated dugouts and wells and land where this liquid waste ends up. I wonder if the future samples of water will be the same as the samples collected this spring during the spring runoff or after a heavy rain.

I am writing to you on behalf of my family regarding the proposed hog barn by HyLife TRC 12-090 to be built on SE ¼ 17-2-23 in the municipality of Deloraine-Winchester. We have many concerns with a hog barn this size being built in such close proximity to several residences which are generational farms. Speaking for ourselves directly who own 2 properties (one within half a mile of the proposed site) we have moved here recently to help out with the 5 generation farm and invested heavily into our hobby farm into an area and community that clearly shows a declining population.

One of our main concerns is the strong odours that would be emitted. At any given wind direction, there will be several residences and facilities negatively impacted. We feel there has been little consideration into the actual devastation that will impact the golf course, the dam, the town and the cottage area; not to mention the recreational use with many hunting cabins, wildlife and a snoman snowmobile trail that will all be negatively impacted.

We run a competitive show jumping and training facility of sport horses which incorporates an outdoor riding facility which will be directly affected. The decision to build this hog barn AND process its waste in the form of fertilizer again within a mile from our home also negatively impacts the resale of our beautiful acreage. We are proud owners of conservation land so we worry that the stench, run off and excessive amount of water needed to run a facility of this size may have **long lasting effects on more than the humans** that inhabit the area. Our conservation study clearly indicates we are proudly home to many endangered or threatened species.

The reality is, odour caused from decomposing manure, rotting feed, and dead pigs, are all a reality of a large-scale hog barn. I must ask the question – is this worth it for the 4 jobs it creates??? How can you reassure us that the aquafer they are pulling water from will remain viable and uncontaminated?

We are also concerned that with the increase of heavy truck traffic, as our roads will continue to deteriorate. This is a municipality that struggles to maintain roads adequately no matter what the season. Examples: the culvert for my road 7N took over a year to be replaced after being washed out. Flossie road saw a major culvert wash out - again it took months to fix with residents having to drive miles out of their way to get to town. These roads are never plowed in a timely manner so I wonder how a feed truck/ Rothsay/ pig hauler will manage and stay on its daily schedule – let alone the maintenance the roads will require. So the additional daily traffic on an otherwise quiet gravel road will affect the roads condition.

There is very little to benefit from this operation – the site landowners/investors conveniently live 20 minutes away from the site and already operate an extremely viable business; BUT the municipality gets a very small contribution of tax money, the town, the neighbors, the airport the golf course & dam all will suffer. Why not build it beside their home and in their own town ?

Not to mention the pigs themselves – can one person seriously look after 2,500 pigs each day? A hog operation can attempt to control these odours, but a certain degree of them are unavoidable. This would undoubtedly lead to decreased quality of life permanently, as well as decreased property values in the area.

Once this barn is built it will remain there, not only for our lifetime, but future generations as well. Please take our concerns seriously as this decision has the power to impact our quality of life and our children permanently. We recently submitted a petition to your office with the names of nearly every resident within a five-mile radius of this proposed hog barn.

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
