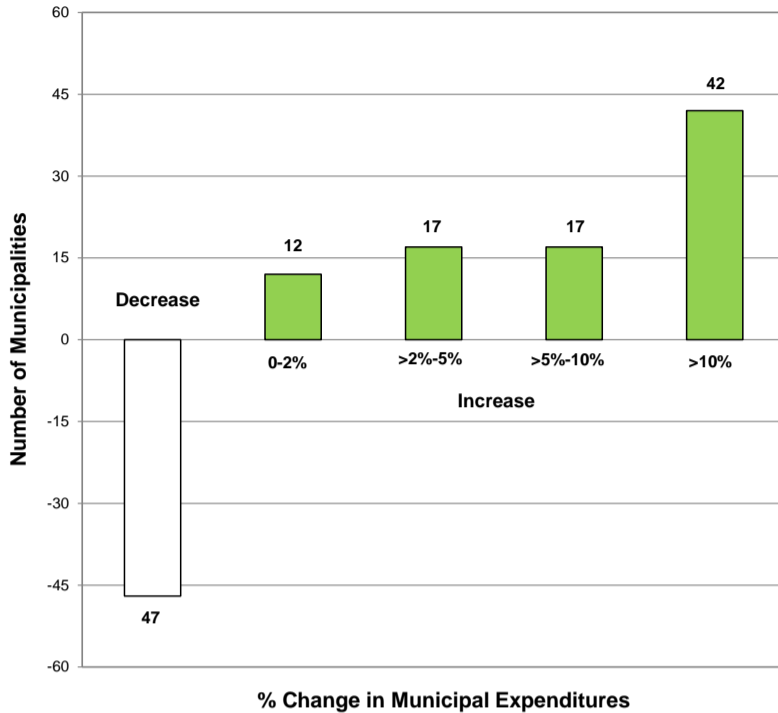


**COMPARISON OF 2018 TO 2017 BUDGETED MUNICIPAL EXPENDITURES**

**2018 municipal budgets increased over 2017 in 88 or 65% of municipalities:**

- 12 or 9% of municipalities had increased expenditures less than 2%
- 34 or 25% of municipalities had increased expenditures between 2% and 10%
- 42 or 31% of municipalities had increased expenditures more than 10%

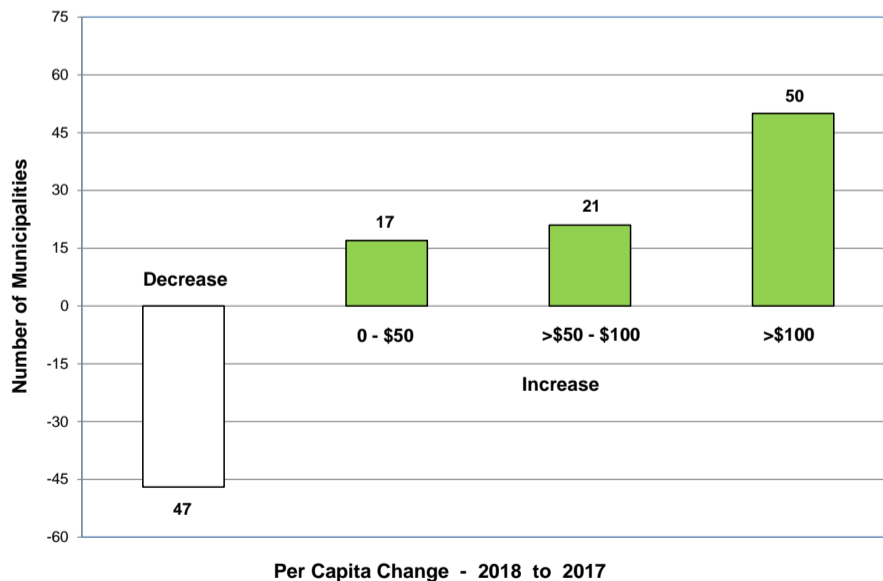
**2018 municipal budgets decreased over 2017 in 47 or 35% of municipalities**

**2018 municipal expenditures increased by more than \$50 per resident in 71 or 53% of municipalities**

- 50 or 37% had increases in 2018 municipal expenditures of more than \$100 per resident
