
## COMPARISON OF 2019 TO 2018 BUDGETED MUNICIPAL EXPENDITURES

In 2019, municipal budgets decreased over 2018 in 70 or 52% of municipalities.


2019 municipal budgets increased over 2018 in 65 or 48% of municipalities:

- 8 or 6% of municipalities had increased expenditures less than 2%
- 30 or 22% of municipalities had increased expenditures between 2% and 10%
- 27 or 20% of municipalities had increased expenditures more than 10%

Municipal Expenditures Per Capita Change

In 2019, municipal expenditures decreased by more than \$50 per resident in 49 or 36% of municipalities

46 or 34% had decreases in 2019 municipal expenditures of more than \$100 per resident

2019 municipal expenditures increased by \$50 or less per resident in 9 or 7% of municipalities

- 39 or 29% had increases in 2019 municipal expenditures of more than \$100 per resident
