#### Important Notice to All Elected Officials and Chief Administrative Officers in the Winnipeg Metropolitan Region

#### Winnipeg Metropolitan Regional Restrictions under the Pandemic Response System

Effective September 28, 2020, Manitoba's public health officials will elevate the #RestartMB Response System level for the Winnipeg Metropolitan Region (WMR) to **Orange: Restricted**.

The Winnipeg Metropolitan Region includes the following municipalities:

- RM of St. Clements

- Village of Dunnottar

Under the **Orange: Restricted** level, public gatherings in the WMR will be restricted to 10 people, both indoors and outdoors. Masks will be mandatory in all indoor public places in the WMR.
