Important Notice to all Chief Administrative Officers And Elected Officials

Feedback requested: Mitigation and Preparedness Program

Manitoba Municipal Relations and Manitoba Infrastructure would like your input on the development of a new Mitigation and Preparedness Program (MPP).

Announced earlier this year, the MPP will support municipalities in mitigating against future disasters. Under the program, when Manitoba establishes a Disaster Financial Assistance (DFA) program that is eligible for cost-sharing with Canada under DFA Arrangements, municipalities would have the option either to:

- pay the provincial/municipal DFA deductible (based on the new formula); or
- invest an amount equal to the Municipality's DFA deductible into a disaster mitigation and preparedness project. If the project proposed by the municipality is approved by Manitoba, Manitoba would then reimburse municipalities for 100% of their eligible DFA claim.
