#### Important Notice to all Chief Administrative Officers

#### Municipal Enforcement Support Program

The Municipal Enforcement Support Program recognizes that the COVID-19 pandemic has had financial impacts on municipalities and that many municipalities may not have the capacity within existing budgets to increase enforcement capacity.

The province is making funding, training, and coordination supports available to assist you in enforcing public health orders within your municipality. A strong enforcement approach is a key aspect of controlling the spread of the virus, ensuring the continued health and economic well-being of your municipality.

**Any municipality that is interested in enforcing public health orders should apply to the program.**

Each municipality will have received a letter on Friday, November 6, 2020 advising of the program intake and including the attached program guidelines.

**This bulletin is a reminder to complete the attached intake form and submit it by email to [mrmca@gov.mb.ca](mailto:mrmca@gov.mb.ca) by Friday, November 13, 2020 to participate in the program's first intake.**

As discussed during the related call with municipalities held on Monday, November 9, 2020, please see attached a Frequently Asked Questions document to help facilitate the completion of the Intake Form.

A supporting council resolution is required, but may follow the application by Friday, November 20, 2020.

Municipalities can expect the province to review intake forms within one business day.
